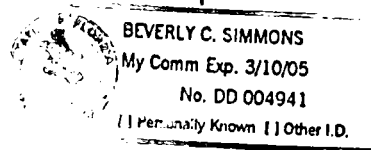

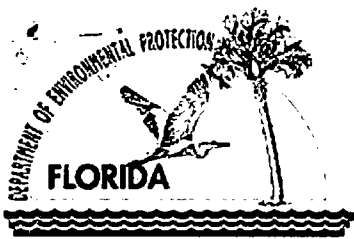



Under Section 403.815 of the Florida Statutes and Rule 62-701.320(8)(a) of the Florida Administrative Code, you (the applicant) are required to publish at your own expense the enclosed Notice of Application.
