Please find attached the 2015 adjusted financial assurance cost estimate for the Taft Transfer Station and Material Recovery Facility owned and operated by Taft Transfer Station, Inc. The most recent approved cost estimate of \$200,131.38 has been adjusted by an inflation factor of 1.5% as directed in the FDEP Memorandum dated January 7, 2015 (see attached Form 62-701900(28).
