Both results shall be forwarded to the department together with a report of actions that may be needed to mitigate the problem.
- 8. After one year of sampling, the department may be requested to modify the sampling parameters and schedule.

TOMOKA LANDFILL DRAINAGE DISCHARGE LOG



In conformance with requirements for increased protection of the State's groundwater and any activities which have an impact on the groundwater, we are submitting a monitoring program plan in compliance with Rule 17-4.246 (see attached Enviro Lab monitoring program schedule). Please note the Environmental Control Laboratory will also conduct those parameters such as conductivity, chlorides, pH, nitrates (NO₂), iron and heavy metals. The new wells located at the Plymouth Avenue landfill will fall under a separate monitoring program for one year. New wells shall be sampled quarterly for the first year. An initial and annual scan shall be made for volatile and extractable organic pollutants in Wells 2, 2s, 5, 5s, 17 and 17s and in the stormwater pond(s). These wells and pond(s) shall be monitored for heavy metals, TDS, TOC, NH_A , pH, cl, SO_A , nitrates, iron and conductivity.

I would appreciate your direction in this matter. Perhaps when the new permit is issued this area could be clarified.

Also be notified that future delays will not exist now that I am trained in Atomic Absorption Spectroscopy.


