Dear Mr. Bejnar:

On behalf of JE Tires Enterprises, Inc. and pursuant to your letter dated July 27, 2015 and FNOV dated September 18, 2015, we are herewith submitting for your review and approval our Closure Cost Estimate for the above captioned facility. The maximum waste tire inventory is established at 50,000 tires.

Even though our actual cost covering loading, transportation and disposal of the subject amount of waste tires amounts to \$0.50/Tire, we are basing our cost estimate on \$1.00/Tire. This to comply with earlier correspondence from your office requesting that we increase the per tire disposal cost in accordance with fees employed by certain Miami-Dade waste tire installations.

This leads to the following closure cost calculation:

**Total Closure Cost is 50,000 X \$1.00 = \$50,000.00**

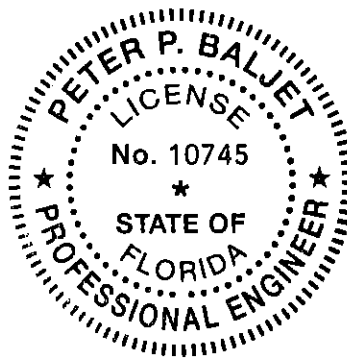
Upon receipt of your approval, JE Tires Enterprises, Inc. will provide the corresponding proof of financial assurance.
