This letter constitutes notice that a permit will be required for your project pursuant to Chapter(s) 403, Florida Statutes.

Your applications for permit remains <u>incomplete</u>. Please provide the information listed below promptly. Evaluation of your proposed project will be delayed until all requested information has been received.

The following information is required in support of the solid waste application [Chapters 17-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)]:

- 1. Provide proof of publication of notice of application as per FAC Section 17-701.030(6), see attachment.
- Provide documentation of Hardee County's possession of an approved Comprehensive Quality Assurance Plan (CQAP) for the sampling and analysis as required for the referenced facility. You are requested to work directly with Ms. Sylvia Labie of the QA Section in Tallahassee to obtain approval of the quality assurance plan.

Provide updated financial responsibility cost estimates for closure and long-term care of the facilities for approval by this office. Please use the attached form and describe the basis of estimate for each item. Cost estimates must be signed and sealed by a professional engineer. Approved cost estimates will be forwarded to Mr. Fred Wick of the Solid Waste Section in Tallahassee. You are requested to work directly with him to obtain approval of Hardee County's financial responsibility documents.

 - d. Update stormwater calculations for treatment.
 - e. Operations description for spotters before and during dumping.

The Groundwater Cleanup Section has reviewed the Application for Permit to Operate Solid Waste Resource Recovery and Management Facility and has initial comments. This application should be a complete document that can stand alone. All information and items in Section 17-28.700(6)(d), Florida Administrative Code (FAC), shall be provided. The geological information and analytical data should be updated, summarized and evaluated to determine whether the existing Groundwater Monitoring Plan (GWMP) is sufficient for this application. Until all of the requested information is provided to the Department, a complete review cannot be provided.

- Monitor well construction details and lithology logs, including elevations, should be provided. Geologic cross-sections, from east to west and north to south, should be constructed that illustrate the various lithologies and their relationships.
- A recent potentiometric map for the Floridan aquifer must be provided.
- Water table maps for the wet and dry seasons should be provided.
- 4) All available water level information should be provided. This data should be provided in tabular form (including top of casing elevations, depth to water, corresponding water level elevations and monitoring interval length) and in graphic form showing the interpretation of the groundwater flow direction to verify the direction of groundwater flow and to estimate fluctuations in the water table.

- 5) An updated summary of analytical data for all sampling periods should be provided in tabular form. All parameters which have exceeded maximum contaminant levels should be graphically displayed over time to evaluate the trends. Analytical data for leachate indicator parameters should also be graphically displayed over time to evaluate the trends. Once this information is provided, monitoring parameters can be evaluated.
- 6) All sampling and analyses should be conducted in accordance with a Department approved Comprehensive Quality Assurance Plan (Comp QAP) to comply with the requirements of Chapter 17-160, F.A.C. Documentation of a Department approved Comp QAP for all sampling and analyses should be provided.
- 7) Updated land use information for the area surrounding the landfill and a current well survey should be provided. Attachment 2 is not dated, so it is not known how current that information is. The well survey should include the address, well usage and construction details, such as casing depth and total depth, and each well on the map should be identified.
- 8) Section 17-4.050(3), F.A.C., states that where required by Chapter 471 or 492, Florida Statutes (F.S.), applicable portions of permit applications and documents which are submitted to the Department for public record shall be signed, sealed and dated by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them. Geological portions of documents and submittals should be signed, sealed and dated by a Florida registered professional geologist in accordance with Chapter 492, F.S., and engineering portions of documents and submittals should be signed, sealed and dated by a Florida registered professional engineer in accordance with Chapter 471, F.S.
- 9) Please note that our review did not include a review of the file to determine whether the County has complied with specific conditions 18, 19 and 20 of Permit #SO25-096551.

Dear Mr. Prestridge:

We are in receipt of a copy of your FDER application for a permit to operate a solid waste resource recovery and management facility. As you have already noted in your engineering services agreement with Wade-Trim, compliance with and preparation of a surface water management plan that meets the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) rule criteria identified in Chapters 40D-4 and 40D-40, Florida Administrative Code, will be required. Although we have issued one SWFWMD permit to date (MSW#407767.00) it only addressed a 5.00 acre project area ("Recycle Center") within the total land area of 98.30 acres that Hardee County owns. The construction of ditches, (stormwater) ponds, and control structures for stormwater control dictate the need for a Management and Storage of Surface Water (MSW) permit.

Based upon the information received at the District on June 12, 1992, it appears that a General Construction Permit is required for your project before construction can begin on the site.

I have enclosed the appropriate application. Please complete and return it with four (4) copies of all requested information. An application fee of \$1,600.00 will be required for the proposed 11.8 acre project area.

DETAILED SOIL MAP UNITS

SOIL DESCRIPTION

10 - Pomona fine sand. ¹ This is a nearly level, poorly drained soil in large areas on low ridges in the flatwoods. Slopes are smooth to concave and range from 0 to 2 percent. Individual areas are broad and oblong and range from 15 to 200 acres in size.

Typically, the surface layer is black fine sand about 3 inches thick. The subsurface layer is fine sand about 24 inches thick. The upper 7 inches is gray, and the lower 17 inches is light gray. The subsoil extends to a depth of 80 inches. The upper 8 inches is dark reddish brown fine sand coated with organic matter, the middle 22 inches is brown fine sand, and the lower 23 inches is gray fine sandy loam.

Included with this soil in mapping are small areas of Basinger, Myakka, Smyrna, and Wauchula soils. In 80 percent of the mapped areas, the included soils make up 10 to 15 percent of the acreage. In 20 percent of the mapped areas, the included soils make up either less than 10 percent or more than 15 percent.

In most years this Pomona soil has a water table at a depth of 10 for 1 to 3 months and at a depth of less than 40 inches for more than 6 months.

The available water capacity is very low to low in all layers except the lower part of the subsoil, where it is moderate. Natural fertility is low. Permeability is moderately slow in the lower part of the subsoil, and rapid in the other layers.

This soil, is mainly in natural vegetation or is used for improved pasture. The natural vegetation includes longleaf and slash pine and sawpalmetto, gallberry, waxmyrtle, and pineland threeawn.

Wetness and poor soil quality are very severe limitations to use of this soil for cultivated crops. Unless intensive management practices are used, the kinds of crops that can be grown are limited. The soil has medium potential for some vegetable crops if a water control system can

remove excess water during wet seasons and provide water for subsurface irrigation during dry seasons. Crop residue and cover crops are needed to protect the soil from erosion. Seedbed preparation should include bedding of the rows.

The potential of this soil for citrus trees is low even if a carefully designed water control system can maintain the water table below a depth of about 4 feet. The trees should be planted in beds and a vegetative cover maintained between the trees. Areas subject to freezing temperatures in winter are not suitable for citrus trees.

The potential of this soil for improved pasture is medium. Pangolagrass, improved bahiagrass, and white clover grow well if they are well managed. Water control is needed, and grazing should be controlled to prevent overgrazing and weakening of the plants.

This soil has moderately high potential productivity for pine trees, especially for slash pine, if a simple water control system can remove excess surface water. Management concerns are restricted use of equipment during periods of heavy rainfall, seedling mortality, and plant competition.

If used as range, this soil has moderately high potential for creeping bluestem, indiangrass, chalky bluestem, various panicums, and numerous legumes and forbs. If the site is allowed to deteriorate, sawpalmetto and pineland threeawn (wiregrass) become dominant.

This soil is in capability subclass IVw.





GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS SITE

Our entire landfill, which includes the Construction and Demolition Debris Site, is operational Monday through Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. The cost, as agreed to by Hardee County Board of County Commissioners, is \$20.00 a ton for construction and demolition debris. Our entire landfill site is completely fenced in and closed, with controlled access.

Upon entering the landfill, solid waste will be weighed and classified at the scale house. If the load is suitable for disposal at the C&D Site, they will be directed to that area. However, if C&D debris should be mixed with any other type of waste, it will not be accepted for disposal at the C&D Site.

To control unwanted material, attendants will inspect incoming loads, and the C&D Site area daily. If unwanted materials are found in the site, they will be removed and transferred to the Class I Landfill.

The site is spread and compacted daily with a D-7H Caterpillar Bulldozer in one foot lifts when possible. We also have a back-up dozer available on site, if needed.

The C&D Site will be filled and covered according to the sequence shown on the site plan. After completion of fill site no.1, the clay cap for closure will be excavated on the property in an area adjacent to the North side of the site. Excavation and transportation of cover material will be done by a front end loader. The excavation area will not be filled with solid waste.

Hardee County Fire Rescue Department is the responding agency for any emergency.

In response to your initial May 2, 1990, request for an exemption from the requirements of Section 40D-4.041, F.A.C., District staff has evaluated the information you supplied. Based upon the information received, the original discharge of the system will not be substantially increased by the proposed construction, the point of discharge is not being altered, there will be no significant increase in pollution runoff, and there will be no adverse impacts to onsite or offsite wetlands. Therefore, the proposed construction does not meet the definition of an "Alteration", 40D-4.021(7) and no permit is required from the District. The property owner and construction representatives shall assure that erosion and sediment control measures shall be effectively implemented continuously from the beginning of project construction until completion to prevent erosion, transport, and discharge of sediment to any property other than the project area. The sediment and erosion control will be especially important along the eastern boundary of the site since the historical flow across this proposed disposal site enters a nearby ditch and pond area.

For the record, I am noting our conversation of June 25, 1990, and my recent conversation with you wherein I advised that your request for an exemption would be acceptable to the District. The latest drawing received from you on June 27, 1990, that defines the limits of construction of the disposal site along with the proposed 40 ft. stormwater retention swale and fire lane that will be constructed along the perimeter of the site will be kept on file to document your proposed design. In addition, I am noting that we discussed that the construction and demolition debris material would consist essentially

of wood, concrete and other nonhazardous materials that are normally removed from a construction site. Also, as shown on your plan, the construction and demolition site is proposed to be filled no greater than 24 feet above existing natural ground. This 24 feet will consist of a maximum of 22 feet of debris plus a two foot clay cap which will be place over the material upon completion. As a condition of this exemption, I am requesting that you: a) provide me with a copy of the approved DER permit for this disposal site, and b) seed and mulch the perimeter stormwater retention swale.

In closing, you are advised that the information submitted and received at the District on May 2, 1990 and June 27, 1990 will be retained in our Bartow office to support this exemption request. You are further advised that any changes to the information we have retained in our files may require a permit(s) from the District.





A 24,000 cf (0.55 af) retention pond adds another 0.28 acres of impervious surface out of a total of 5.01 acres. Pavement grades route runoff toward the pond, which is capable of retaining the required 1/2 inch of runoff (0.21 af) by a factor of 2.5.

The proposed addition is a 30' x 75' non-attached metal building with associated driveway which is to be constructed in the southeast corner of the site. Total impervious on the site will change from 2.34 acres to 2.42 acres. A new shallow swale with dimensions as shown on the attached drawing will retain any additional runoff from the new construction. Supporting calculations are also on the attached drawing. As we have discussed, I have estimated the remaining life of the County's landfill based on the loading rates you gave me with a 3 per cent per year growth rate, removal of the recyclables, yard waste, and construction and demolition debris and compaction in the baler to 40 lb/cubic foot. Based on these assumptions the landfill has approximately 12 years of useful life before the permitted contours are reached.

Obviously there are a lot of things that could influence landfill life such as recovery of recyclables, compaction achieved, etc., but I believe that 12 years is a reasonable estimate for planning purposes.



INTRODUCTION:

Upon completing refuse deposition in the permitted area of the site, the site will be in a closure configuration. The cost itemized below is for normal site closure. It will be verified, as necessary, on an annual basis to reflect inflation and other factors.

Hardee County intends to use on site native materials, in closing Phase I of the Landfill. The materials are clay, sand, topsoil plants, grasses, etc. The closed portion of the Landfill will also be proposed to be utilized for a spray irrigation field for future use for leachate disposal, in Phase II of our operation.

Hardee County intends to use in-house personnel and equipment for all earth work. Excavation of Fill, loading, hauling, grading and grassing of site.

MONITORING WELLS:

Ground water sampling and monitoring will continue as required by the Permit. No new monitoring wells should be required for closure, Therefore, the estimated cost for installing new monitoring wells for closure operation is \$0.00.

BACKFILL:

It is expected that the disposal site can be readily placed into an acceptable of closure condition; 3:1 slopes and appropriate top grades by using on site equipment and clay materials. Therefore, the cost for this task is estimated \$4,000.00.

CLAY CAP:

The site will be capped by two (2) feet fo compacted clay, utilizing on site clay material. This will require: 38,161 cubic yards, 45,793 loose cubic yards at 20% swell over the 11.82 acre site, which will require soil cover. Therefore, the estimated cost is \$91,586.00.

Landfill Closure Plan

TOPSOIL:

The site development plan requires a topsoil cover of $\frac{6}{5}$ inches over the two (2) feet compacted clay cap (10,971 loose cubic yards at $15\sqrt{3}$ swell). The estimated cost is \$2.00 dollar per loose cubic yard. Therefore, the estimated cost is \$21,942.00.

CONTOUR GRADING/SURFACE WATER:

Placement of the site into a closure configuration and appropriate final cover, requires contour grading to insure surface water drainage. This is accomplished as the materials are geing placed. The site will require finish grading. The estimated cost for this task is \$2,000.00.

GAS MIGRATION CONTROL:

The synthetic liner should prevent any gas migration off site. The leachate collection system should serve the purpose of gas control. Therefore, the estimated cost for gas control is \$0.00.

BENCH MARKS:

The property in which Phase I of the Hardee County Sanitary Landfill is located, has survey markers already in place. The estimated cost for Bench Marks is \$0.00.

LANDSCAPING:

The Hardee County facility will be landscaped using sand and clay found within the property boundries. These soils readily support native vegetation. It is expected that fertilizing will not be required on a regular basis. Estimated cost is \$0.00.

REVEGETATION:

After placing of final cover, seeding of site will be done to provide a quick cover for erosion control, and to provide a permanent grass cover to blend in with the surrounding area. Therefore, the estimated cost is \$500.00.

SECURITY SYSTEM:

The in place fencing, gates, and attendants should provide ample security to the closed site. Estimated cost \$0.00.

CERTIFICATION: \$20,000.00.



ESTIMATED POST CLOSURE PLAN

GROUNDWATER QUALITY SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS:

SAMPLING:

The monitor wells will be sampled quarterly, the first three (3) years. Upon satisfactory results form this program, the sampling will be reduced to a semi-annual frequency for the next seventeen (17) years. Labor, equipment and expenses for each of these events is estimated at \$1,500.00. For twenty (20) years, forty-six (46) events, the estimated cost is \$69,000.00.

CHEMICAL ANALYSIS:

The analytical chemistry cost per sample will be \$300.00. The facility utilizes six (6) groundwater monitoring wells. The total cost for chemical analysis will be (\$300.00/sample) (6 samples/sampling events) (46 events).

Estimated cost \$82,800.00.



In response to your initial May 2, 1990, request for an exemption from the requirements of Section 40D-4.041, F.A.C., District staff has evaluated the information you supplied. Based upon the information received, the original discharge of the system will not be substantially increased by the proposed construction, the point of discharge is not being altered, there will be no significant increase in pollution runoff, and there will be no adverse impacts to onsite Therefore, the proposed construction does not or offsite wetlands. meet the definition of an "Alteration", 40D-4.021(7) and no permit is required from the District. The property owner and construction representatives shall assure that erosion and sediment control measures shall be effectively implemented continuously from the beginning of project construction until completion to prevent erosion, transport, and discharge of sediment to any property other than the project area. The sediment and erosion control will be especially important along the eastern boundary of the site since the historical flow across this proposed disposal site enters a nearby ditch and pond area.

For the record, I am noting our conversation of June 25, 1990, and my recent conversation with you wherein I advised that your request for an exemption would be acceptable to the District. The latest drawing received from you on June 27, 1990, that defines the limits of construction of the disposal site along with the proposed 40 ft. stormwater retention swale and fire lane that will be constructed along the perimeter of the site will be kept on file to document your proposed design. In addition, I am noting that we discussed that the construction and demolition debris material would consist essentially

of wood, concrete and other nonhazardous materials that are normally removed from a construction site. Also, as shown on your plan, the construction and demolition site is proposed to be filled no greater than 24 feet above existing natural ground. This 24 feet will consist of a maximum of 22 feet of debris plus a two foot clay cap which will be place over the material upon completion. As a condition of this exemption, I am requesting that you: a) provide me with a copy of the approved DER permit for this disposal site, and b) seed and mulch the perimeter stormwater retention swale.

In closing, you are advised that the information submitted and received at the District on May 2, 1990 and June 27, 1990 will be retained in our Bartow office to support this exemption request. You are further advised that any changes to the information we have retained in our files may require a permit(s) from the District.

28-5.201 Initiation of Formal Proceedings.

- (1) Initiation of formal proceedings shall be made by petition to the Agency responsible for rendering final Agency action. The term petition as used herein includes any application or other document which expresses a request for formal proceedings. Each petition should be printed, typewritten or otherwise duplicated in legible form on white paper of standard legal size. Unless printed, the impression shall be on one side of the paper only and lines shall be double-spaced and indented.
 - (2) All petitions filed under these rules should contain:
- (a) The name and address of each Agency affected and each Agency's file or identification number, if known;
- (b) The name and address of the petitioner or petitioners, and an explanation of how his/her substantial interests will be affected by the Agency determination;
- (c) A statement of when and how petitioner received notice of the Agency decision of intent to render a decision;
- (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief;
- (f) A demand for relief to which the petitioner deems himself entitled; and
 - (g) Other information which the petitioner contends is material.
- (3) Upon receipt of a petition for formal proceedings, the Agency shall either accept or deny the petition, and if accepted shall elect either to conduct the hearing itself through the Agency head, or member thereof, assign a person authorized by Subsection 120.57(1)(a) or other authority, or request that a Hearing Officer from the Division of Administrative Hearings be assigned to conduct the hearing.
- (a) A petition may be denied if the petitioner does not state adequately a material factual allegation, such as a substantial interest in the Agency determination, or if the petition is untimely.
- (b) The Agency shall promptly give written notice to all parties of the action taken on the petition, and shall state with particularity its reasons therefor.
- (4) If the Agency elects to request that a Hearing Officer of the Division of Administrative Hearings be assigned to conduct the hearing, the Agency shall forward the petition, and all materials filed with the Agency, to the Division of Administrative hearings, and shall notify all parties of its action.

- 4 . Petitions concerning notices of violation when an informal conference is held: 10 days after receipt of notice of completion of the informal conference;
- 5. Petitions concerning other Department actions or proposed actions: 21 days. The petitioner shall also serve a copy of the petition on all other parties to the proceeding, as identified in the published notice, at the time of filing.
- (b) Failure to timely file a petition within the applicable time period after receipt of notice of agency action or receipt of notice of proposed agency action, whichever notice first occurs, shall constitute a waiver if any right to request an administrative proceeding under Chapter 120, F.S.

- If a petition is filed that does not substantially comply with the requirements of subsection (2) of this rule, the Department shall issue an order dismissing the petition with leave to file an amended petition complying with the requirements of this rule within 15 days of service of the order. If an amended petition complying with this rule is not filed (received) within 15 days of service of the order, the petitioner's right to a proceeding under Section 120.57, F.S., is waived.
- When there has been no publication of notice of agency action or notice of proposed agency action as prescribed in Rule 17-103.150, F.A.C., a person who has actual knowledge of the agency action or has knowledge which would lead a reasonable person to conclude that the Department has taken final agency action, has a duty to make further inquiry within 14 days of obtaining such knowledge by contacting the Department to ascertain whether action has occurred. The Department shall upon receipt of such an inquiry, if agency action has occurred, promptly provide the person with notice as prescribed by Rule 17-103.150, F.A.C. Failure of the person to make inquiry with the Department within 14 days after obtaining such knowledge may stop the person from obtaining an administrative proceeding on the agency action.
- (6)(a) "Receipt of notice of agency action" means receipt of written notice of final agency action, as prescribed by Department rule, or the publication, pursuant to Department rule, of notice of final agency action, whichever first occurs.
- "Receipt of notice of proposed agency action" means receipt of written notice (such as a letter of intent) that the Department proposes to take certain action, or the publication pursuant to Department rule of notice of proposed agency action, whichever first occurs.
- Notwithstanding any other provision in this Chapter, should a substantially affected person who fails to timely request a hearing under Section 120.57, F.S., administratively appeal the final Department action or order, the record on appeal shall be limited to:







Dear Mr. Prestridge:

In 1989, several revisions were made to the Department's rule on solid waste Chapter, 17-701, Florida Administrative Code (FAC). One of those revisions (17-701.061, FAC) created new guidelines for the disposal of construction and demolition debris (C&D). According to 17-701.061(2), FAC:

Pursuant to Section 403.706(2), Florida Statutes, each county must initiate by July 1, 1989, a program to develop segregated disposal areas for construction and demolition debris. This program shall be designed to assure that all construction and demolition debris is disposed in segregated areas after August 1, 1990.

The August 1, 1990, deadline is just three months away. In an effort to gauge district-wide compliance with this requirement, the Department hereby requests you to submit a detailed narrative description that discusses your county's current status with regards to this subject and how you plan to meet the August 1, 1990 deadline for segregated disposal of construction and demolition debris.





Information submitted for a permit modification is <u>incomplete</u>. Please provide the information listed below promptly. Evaluation of your proposed project will be delayed until all requested information has been received.

The following information is needed in support of the waste tire processing facility application request [Chapter 17-711, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)]:

- 1. A site plan sheet on which the following items are annotated:
 - a. Description of waste tire pile or processed tire pile dimensions, not to exceed: (1) width: 50 feet; (2) area: 10,000 square feet; and (3) height: 15 feet (FAC 17-711.540(2)(b)).
 - b. Assurance of 50 foot wide fire lane placed around the perimeter of each tire pile (FAC 17-711.540(2)(c)).

Should you desire a waste tire collection center general permit instead of a waste tire processing facility permit, please complete the enclosed General Permit Application, DER Form 17-711.900(2), as well as Items 1. and 2. of this incompleteness letter.
- 8. If you cannot confirm Item 7. above, then you will need to obtain a permit modification for a waste tire processing facility, and must comply with each of the items in 17-711.530, FAC. Enclosed is a copy of the waste tire rule for your use.





29. This disposal area shall be limited to "Construction and Demolition Debris" and "Clean Debris" as defined in F.A.C. Rule 17-701.020. The permittee shall not allow the disposal of "Garbage" or "Special Waste" in the construction and demolition debris disposal area. The permittee shall not allow the disposal of hazardous waste at this site. Hazardous waste is a solid waste identified by the Department as a hazardous waste in Chapter 17-30, F.A.C.



The final cover shall be placed over the entire surface of each completed portion of the filled areas within 180 days after final waste deposit date.
- 16. In accordance with Chapter 17-4, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the Groundwater Monitoring System shall be constructed and sampled by the permittee within ninety (90) days of the issuance of this permit.
- 17. The Groundwater Monitoring System shall be designed and constructed by the permittee in accordance with the plans submitted on July 17, 1985 by Seaburn & Robertson, Inc. and addended information submitted February 27, 1986 and March 25, 1987.

The specific parameters to be sampled and analyzed for are the Primary (17-22.104(1)) and Secondary (17-22.104(2)) Drinking Water Standards listed in Part II, Quality Standards, Analytical Methods, Sampling.

After initial analysis, as required be Specific Condition No. 20, MW-2 will be measured for water levels on a quarterly basis only.

- 22. The field testing, sample collection and preservation and laboratory testing, including quality control procedures, shall be in accordance with methods approved by the Department in accordance with Chapter 17-4.246 and 17-3.401, F.A.C. Approved methods as published by the Department or as published in Standard Methods, A.S.T.M. or EPA methods shall be used. Approved methods for chemical analyses are summarized in the Federal Register, December 1, 1976 (41FR52780) except that turbidity shall be measured by the Nephelometric Method.
- 23. All groundwater monitoring analyses shall be reported on the Department Form 17-1.216(2), Quarterly Report on Groundwater Monitoring. The permittee shall submit to the Department the results of the groundwater monitoring well water quality analysis no later than the fifteenth (15) day of the month immediately following the end of the sampling period. - 25. The permittee shall ensure that the minimum criteria for groundwater specified in Section 17-3.402, F.A.C. shall not be violated within the zone of discharge.
- 26. If any monitoring well becomes damaged or inoperable, the permittee shall submit a written report to the Department within fourteen (14) days of discovery of the problem. Any well in which a water sample cannot be taken is considered inoperable. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the department.
- 3. As provided in Subsections 403.087(6) and 403.712(5), Florida Statutes, the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Nor does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of personal rights, nor infringement or federal, state or local laws or regulations. This permit does not constitute a waiver of or approval of any other department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.
- 4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute state recognition or acknowledgement of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the state. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express state opinion as to title.
- 5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, plant or aquatic life or property and penalties therefore caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and department rules, unless specifically authorized by any order from the department.

- (b) the period of non-compliance, including exact dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the non-compliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the department for penalties or revocation of this permit.

The time period of retention shall be at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report or application unless otherwise specified by department rule.
- c. Records of monitoring information shall include:
- -the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurement;
- -the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;




FIGURE 1.- LOCATION OF MONITOR WELLS.
