Thank you for your application for Waste Tire Small Processing Facility for the above referenced Facility. The Department has assigned DEP Application No. 0019600-010-WT-06 to the application. A Department staff review of the application and supporting documentation, submitted on April 1, 2016, indicates the application is incomplete. Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 62-4.055, F.A.C., please provide the information listed below and refer to this correspondence in your response.

All references in the following text refer to the application, dated March 29, 2016 and received on April 1, 2016. The application form 62-701.900(24) and supporting documentation contained 9 pages. The submittal can be viewed at the following link.

- 1. Part II Section A (page 2) did not fully describe the facility's operations and storage to give reasonable assurance that the requirements of Rule 62-711.540, F.A.C., will be met. Our recommendation is to specifically address each item in Rule 62-711.540, F.A.C., in an attachment to the application. The topics should include but not be limited to:
 - a. if accepting tires from the public, signage at the facility entrance (for example, operating hours, cost for disposal, etc.) and an attendant must be at the facility when open for business;
 - b. fire protection (see below about a copy of the fire safety survey);
 - c. emergency preparedness manual (a copy must be attached);
 - d. availability of communication equipment;
 - e. mosquito and rodent control;
 - f. how tire piles will be arranged (sizes of tire piles, set-back from or between tire piles, set back from body of water including wetlands); and
 - g. if any waste tire pile will be taller than 10 feet, how the temperature of the waste tire pile will be monitored.

- 2. Part II Section B provided the make and model of a portable tire sheer and de-rimmer. What type of equipment will be used to transfer cut up tires between the storage area, processing area, and into 20-yard bins for shipment?
- 3. Part II Section C mentioned the product from processing the waste tires. However, Section C is about the waste from processing the tires. Please provide the following necessary information:
 - a. There will be waste from the storage and processing activities, for example, small pieces of tires and dust. How will that waste be handled?
 - b. Where will the waste (small tire pieces and dust) be disposed? They cannot be disposed in the C&D disposal area.
- 4. Part III Attachments The following required attachments were not provided:
 - a. A plot plan showing the required details;
 - b. A copy of the fire safety survey (you can obtain this from the fire department); and
 - c. A copy of the emergency preparedness manual. (Please include when DEP will be notified. Our phone number is 407-897-4300; our e-mail address is DEP_CD@dep.state.fl.us.)

In order for the Department to continue processing your application, please submit the requested information as soon as possible. The Department must receive a response within 30 days of the date of this letter, [May 19, 2016], unless a written request for additional time to provide the requested information is submitted and approved. Pursuant to Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. and Section 120.60, F.S., failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline may result in denial of the application. You are encouraged to contact this office to discuss the items requested to assist you in developing a complete and adequate response.
