This is the third inspection of the construction activities at Cell 13. Operator Dave Collins took Mr. Rainey to Cell 13 in a pickup truck. Mr. Rainey observed the following:

- 1. Much of the protective soil layer was in place over the primary geocomposite drainage layer. Rain water had collected at the east side of the cell. Workers were using a hose within a leachate riser to pump the water out into the retention basin on the east side of the cell.
- 2. One bulldozer was spreading the soil layer onto the southern slope of the cell.
