This permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rule(s) 62-4, 62-302, 62-330, 62-520, 62-522, 62-550, and 62-701. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans and other documents, attached hereto or referenced in Specific Condition #A.2., and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

To construct a temporary stormwater management system within Cells 2, 3, and 4 of Phase II of a Class I landfill, referred to as the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC), Class I Landfill, subject to the specific and general conditions attached, located at the north end of Knights Trail Road, 2 miles east of I-75, northeast of Venice, Sarasota County, Florida. specific conditions attached are for the construction of:

A temporary stormwater management system within Cells 2-4 of the Phase II Class I landfill.

#### Replaces Permit No.: N/A, new

This permit contains compliance items summarized in Attachment 1 that shall be complied with and submitted to the Department by the dates noted. If the compliance dates are not met and submittals are not received by the Department on the dates noted, enforcement action may be initiated to assure compliance with the conditions of this permit.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations and restrictions set forth in this permit, are "permit conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.141, 403.161, 403.727, or 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violation of these conditions.
- 2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
- 3. As provided in subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of rights, nor any infringement of federal, State, or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in this permit.
- 4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgment of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
- 5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
- 6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed and used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, are required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.
- 7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at reasonable times, access to the premises where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:
  - (a) Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under conditions of the permit;
  - (b) Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
  - (c) Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:
  - (a) A description of and cause of noncompliance; and
  - (b) The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the noncompliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

- 9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.
- 10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and Florida Statues after a reasonable time for compliance; provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or Department rules.
- 11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rule 62-4.120 and 62-730.300, Florida Administrative Code, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.
- 12. This permit or a copy thereof shall be kept at the work site of the permitted activity.
- 13. This permit also constitutes:
  - (a) Determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT)
  - (b) Determination of Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD)
  - (c) Certification of compliance with State Water Quality Standards (Section 401, PL 92-500)
  - (d) Compliance with New Source Performance Standards

## GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 14. The permittee shall comply with the following:
  - (a) Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.
  - (b) The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.
    - (c) Records of monitoring information shall include:
      - 1. the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
      - the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
      - the dates analyses were performed;
      - 4. the person responsible for performing the analyses;
      - 5. the analytical techniques or methods used;
      - 6. the results of such analyses.
- 15. When requested by the Department, the permittee shall within a reasonable time furnish any information required by law which is needed to determine compliance with the permit. If the permittee becomes aware the relevant facts were not submitted or were incorrect in the permit application or in any report to the Department, such facts or information shall be corrected promptly.

## SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -Solid Waste Facility General Requirements

- 1. **Facility Designation.** This site shall be classified as a Class I landfill and shall be constructed, operated, closed, monitored and maintained in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 62-4, 62-302, 62-330, 62-520, 62-522, 62-550, and 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and all applicable requirements of Department rules.
- 2. Permit Application Documentation. This permit is valid for construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill (including removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal), at the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex in accordance with Department rules and the reports, plans and other information prepared by SCS Engineers (unless otherwise specified) as follows:
  - a. Application for Construction/Minor Modification to Class I Operation Permit Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC)... (one 3-ring binder and plan set) dated January 19, 2012 (received January 23, 2012), as revised, replaced or amended (replacement pages inserted into original\*) dated March 2, 2012 (received March 5, 2012). This information includes, but is not limited to:
    - 1) Plan Set titled, Sarasota County Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex Stormwater Management System Improvements (7 Sheets) dated February 2012 (received March 5, 2012).
  - b. Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex Cells 1-4 of Phase II Class I Landfill Certification of Construction Completion Report, including Attachments A through F, received on February 12, 2010 and March 4, 2010, prepared by HDR Engineering, Inc. and Ardaman & Associates, Inc., as revised, replaced, or amended April 13, 2010 and May 26, 2010.

#### 3. Permit Modifications.

- a. Any construction or operation not previously approved as part of this permit shall require a separate Department permit unless the Department determines a permit modification to be more appropriate. Any significant changes to the construction or operation at the facility shall require a permit modification. Permits shall be modified in accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-4.080, F.A.C. A modification which is reasonably expected to lead to substantially different environmental impacts which require a detailed review by the Department is considered a substantial modification.
- b. This permit authorizes the construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill and the subsequent removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal, only.
- 4. **Permit Renewal.** No later than March 1, 2017, the permittee shall apply for a renewal of a permit on forms and in a manner prescribed by the Department, in order to assure conformance with all applicable Department rules. Permits shall be renewed at least every five years as required by Rule 62-701.320(10)(b), F.A.C.

# SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -Solid Waste Facility General Requirements

- 5. **Professional Certification.** Where required by Chapter 471 (P.E.) or Chapter 492 (P.G.), Florida Statutes, applicable portions of permit applications and supporting documents which are submitted to the Department for public record shall be signed and sealed by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them.
- 6. **General Conditions.** The permittee shall be aware of and operate under the "General Conditions." General Conditions are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.
- 7. **Permit Acceptance.** By acceptance of this Permit, the Permittee certifies that he/she has read and understands the obligations imposed by the Specific and General Conditions contained herein and also including date of permit expiration and renewal deadlines. It is a violation of this permit for failure to comply with all conditions and deadlines.
- 8. **Regulations.** Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., effective January 6, 2010, is incorporated into this permit by reference. In the event that the regulations governing this permitted operation are revised, the Department shall notify the permittee, and the permittee shall request modification of those specific conditions which are affected by the revision of regulations to incorporate those revisions.
- 9. **Prohibitions.** The prohibitions of Rule 62-701.300, F.A.C., shall not be violated by the activities at this facility.
  - a. In the event that limestone is encountered during excavation or construction activities, the excavation/construction activities shall cease and the Department shall be notified within 24 hours of discovery. Written notification shall be submitted within 7 days of discovery. The written notification shall include the location, elevation, and extent of limestone noted on a plan sheet, a description of the materials encountered, and a plan of action which ensures that groundwater will not be adversely affected by the continued construction and operation of the facility. Excavation or construction activities shall not resume in the affected area until the Department-approved plan of action has been completed.
  - b. In the event that surface depressions or other occurrences which may be indicative of sinkhole activity or subsurface instability, are discovered on-site, or within 500 feet of the site, the Department shall be notified in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6.b. The written notification shall include a description of the incident, the location and size of the affected area shown on an appropriate plan sheet, and a corrective action plan which describes the actions necessary to prevent the unimpeded discharge of waste or leachate into ground or surface water.
  - c. Open burning of solid waste is prohibited except in accordance with Rule 62-701.300(3) and Chapter 62-256, F.A.C. All fires which require longer than one (1) hour to extinguish must be promptly reported to the Department in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6.b.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART B - Construction Requirements

- 1. **Construction.** All significant construction activities shall be approved by the Department prior to initiating work, unless specifically authorized otherwise.
  - a. This permit authorizes the construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill and the subsequent removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal.
- 2. **Certification of Construction Completion.** All information required by this Specific Condition shall be signed and sealed by a registered professional engineer or land surveyor as appropriate.
  - a. Within sixty (60) days after construction of the temporary stormwater system has been completed and <u>prior to</u> operation of the system, the following activities shall be completed and submitted by the permittee, and shall be approved by the Department:
    - 1) The owner or operator shall submit a Certification of Construction Completion, Form 62-701.900(2), signed and sealed by the professional engineer in charge of construction and quality assurance to the Department for approval, and shall arrange for Department representatives to inspect the construction in the company of the permittee, the engineer, and the facility operator.
    - 2) The owner or operator shall submit Record Drawings/Documents showing all changes (i.e. all additions, deletions, revisions to the plans previously approved by the Department including site grades and elevations). The Record Documents shall include asbuilt plans details and elevations (survey) as appropriate.
    - 3) The owner or operator shall submit a narrative indicating all changes in plans, the cause of the deviations, and certification of the Record Drawings/Documents by the Engineer to the Department.
    - 4) The professional engineer of record shall submit to the Department a final report to verify conformance with the plans and specifications in accordance with Rules 62-701.400(7) and (8), F.A.C.
  - b. Within sixty (60) days after construction completion and prior to disposal in each Cell 2 through 4, the activities and information specified in Specific Condition #B.2.a. above, related to the removal of the temporary stormwater management system and restoration of the leachate collection system shall be completed and submitted by the permittee, and shall be approved by the Department:
- 3. Leachate Collection and Removal System.
  - a. Upon removal of the installed temporary stormwater management system in Cells 2-4, the leachate collection and removal system for each Cell shall be restored to its prior as-built conditions [ref. SC #A.2.b., above] unless otherwise specified by this permit.

# SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - Operation Requirements

- 1. Facility Operation Requirements.
  - a. The permittee shall operate this facility in accordance with Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., and Operation Permit No. 130542-007-SO/01 or its successors.
  - c. In no event shall waste be accepted for disposal in the Phase II, Cells 2-4 portion of the CCSWDC Class I landfill until the following requirements have been completed and submitted by the Permittee, and approved by the Department:
    - 1) Certification of Construction Completion requirements of Specific Conditions #B.2.b.
- 2. **Facility Personnel.** The owner or operator shall provide adequate personnel for constructing, operating, monitoring and maintaining the facility in an orderly, safe, and sanitary manner.
- 3. **Control of Access**. Access to, and use of, the facility shall be controlled as required by Rule 62-701.500(5), F.A.C.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART D - Recordkeeping

1. Report submittals. Unless otherwise specified, all submittals, notifications, requests for permit modification, reports for compliance with this permit, etc. shall be sent to: Solid Waste Section, Department of Environmental Protection, Southwest District Office, 13051 North Telecom Parkway, Temple Terrace, Fl. 33637-0926.

The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans and other documents, attached hereto or referenced in Specific Condition #A.2., and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

To construct a temporary stormwater management system within Cells 2, 3, and 4 of Phase II of a Class I landfill, referred to as the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC), Class I Landfill, subject to the specific and general conditions attached, located at the north end of Knights Trail Road, 2 miles east of I-75, northeast of Venice, Sarasota County, Florida. The specific conditions attached are for the construction of:

1. A temporary stormwater management system within Cells 2-4 of the Phase II Class I landfill.

This permit contains compliance items summarized in **Attachment 1** that shall be complied with and submitted to the Department by the dates noted. If the compliance dates are not met and submittals are not received by the Department on the dates noted, enforcement action may be initiated to assure compliance with the conditions of this permit.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations and restrictions set forth in this permit, are "permit conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.141, 403.161, 403.727, or 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violation of these conditions.
- 2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
- 3. As provided in subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of rights, nor any infringement of federal, State, or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in this permit.
- 4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgment of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
- 5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
- 6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed and used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, are required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.
- 7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at reasonable times, access to the premises where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:
  - (a) Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under conditions of the permit;
  - (b) Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
  - (c) Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:

- (a) A description of and cause of noncompliance; and
- (b) The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the noncompliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

- 9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.
- 10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and Florida Statues after a reasonable time for compliance; provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or Department rules.
- 11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rule 62-4.120 and 62-730.300, Florida Administrative Code, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.

  - (a) Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.
  - (b) The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.
    - (c) Records of monitoring information shall include:
      - 1. the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;

## SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -Solid Waste Facility General Requirements

- 1. **Facility Designation.** This site shall be classified as a Class I landfill and shall be constructed, operated, closed, monitored and maintained in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 62-4, 62-302, 62-330, 62-520, 62-522, 62-550, and 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and all applicable requirements of Department rules.
- 2. **Permit Application Documentation.** This permit is valid for **construction** of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill (including removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal), at the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex in accordance with Department rules and the reports, plans and other information prepared by SCS Engineers (unless otherwise specified) as follows:
  - a. Application for Construction/Minor Modification to Class I Operation Permit Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC)... (one 3-ring binder and plan set) dated January 19, 2012 (received January 23, 2012), as revised, replaced or amended (replacement pages inserted into original\*) dated March 2, 2012 (received March 5, 2012). This information includes, but is not limited to:
    - 1) Plan Set titled, Sarasota County Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex Stormwater Management System Improvements (7 Sheets) dated February 2012 (received March 5, 2012).
  - b. Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex Cells 1-4 of Phase II Class I Landfill Certification of Construction Completion Report, including Attachments A through F, received on February 12, 2010 and March 4, 2010, prepared by HDR Engineering, Inc. and Ardaman & Associates, Inc., as revised, replaced, or amended April 13, 2010 and May 26, 2010.

#### 3. Permit Modifications.

- a. Any construction or operation not previously approved as part of this permit shall require a separate Department permit unless the Department determines a permit modification to be more appropriate. Any significant changes to the construction or operation at the facility shall require a permit modification. Permits shall be modified in accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-4.080, F.A.C. A modification which is reasonably expected to lead to substantially different environmental impacts which require a detailed review by the Department is considered a substantial modification.
- b. This permit authorizes the construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill and the subsequent removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal, only.
- 4. **Permit Renewal. No later than March 1, 2017**, the permittee shall apply for a renewal of a permit on forms and in a manner prescribed by the Department, in order to assure conformance with all applicable Department rules. Permits shall be renewed at least every five years as required by Rule 62-701.320(10)(b), F.A.C.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -Solid Waste Facility General Requirements

- 5. **Professional Certification.** Where required by Chapter 471 (P.E.) or Chapter 492 (P.G.), Florida Statutes, applicable portions of permit applications and supporting documents which are submitted to the Department for public record shall be signed and sealed by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them.
- 6. **General Conditions.** The permittee shall be aware of and operate under the "General Conditions." General Conditions are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.
- 7. **Permit Acceptance.** By acceptance of this Permit, the Permittee certifies that he/she has read and understands the obligations imposed by the Specific and General Conditions contained herein and also including date of permit expiration and renewal deadlines. It is a violation of this permit for failure to comply with all conditions and deadlines.
- 8. **Regulations.** Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., effective January 6, 2010, is incorporated into this permit by reference. In the event that the regulations governing this permitted operation are revised, the Department shall notify the permittee, and the permittee shall request modification of those specific conditions which are affected by the revision of regulations to incorporate those revisions.
- 9. **Prohibitions.** The prohibitions of Rule 62-701.300, F.A.C., shall not be violated by the activities at this facility.
  - a. In the event that limestone is encountered during excavation or construction activities, the excavation/construction activities shall cease and the Department shall be notified within 24 hours of discovery. Written notification shall be submitted within 7 days of discovery. The written notification shall include the location, elevation, and extent of limestone noted on a plan sheet, a description of the materials encountered, and a plan of action which ensures that groundwater will not be adversely affected by the continued construction and operation of the facility. Excavation or construction activities shall not resume in the affected area until the Department-approved plan of action has been completed.
  - b. In the event that surface depressions or other occurrences which may be indicative of sinkhole activity or subsurface instability, are discovered on-site, or within 500 feet of the site, the Department shall be notified in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6.b. The written notification shall include a description of the incident, the location and size of the affected area shown on an appropriate plan sheet, and a corrective action plan which describes the actions necessary to prevent the unimpeded discharge of waste or leachate into ground or surface water.
  - c. Open burning of solid waste is prohibited except in accordance with Rule 62-701.300(3) and Chapter 62-256, F.A.C. All fires which require longer than one (1) hour to extinguish must be promptly reported to the Department in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6.b.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART B - Construction Requirements

1. **Construction.** All significant construction activities shall be approved by the Department prior to initiating work, unless specifically authorized otherwise.

- a. This permit authorizes the construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill and the subsequent removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal.
- 2. Certification of Construction Completion. All information required by this Specific Condition shall be signed and sealed by a registered professional engineer or land surveyor as appropriate.
  - a. Within sixty (60) days after construction of the temporary stormwater system has been completed and <u>prior to</u> operation of the system, the following activities shall be completed and submitted by the permittee, and shall be approved by the Department:
    - 1) The owner or operator shall submit a Certification of Construction Completion, Form 62-701.900(2), signed and sealed by the professional engineer in charge of construction and quality assurance to the Department for approval, and shall arrange for Department representatives to inspect the construction in the company of the permittee, the engineer, and the facility operator.
    - 2) The owner or operator shall submit Record Drawings/Documents showing all changes (i.e. all additions, deletions, revisions to the plans previously approved by the Department including site grades and elevations). The Record Documents shall include asbuilt plans details and elevations (survey) as appropriate.
    - 3) The owner or operator shall submit a narrative indicating all changes in plans, the cause of the deviations, and certification of the Record Drawings/Documents by the Engineer to the Department.
    - 4) The professional engineer of record shall submit to the Department a final report to verify conformance with the plans and specifications in accordance with Rules 62-701.400(7) and (8), F.A.C.
  - b. Within sixty (60) days after construction completion and prior to disposal in each Cell 2 through 4, the activities and information specified in Specific Condition #B.2.a. above, related to the removal of the temporary stormwater management system and restoration of the leachate collection system shall be completed and submitted by the permittee, and shall be approved by the Department:
- 3. Leachate Collection and Removal System.
  - a. Upon removal of the installed temporary stormwater management system in Cells 2-4, the leachate collection and removal system for each Cell shall be restored to its prior as-built conditions [ref. SC #A.2.b., above] unless otherwise specified by this permit.

# SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - Operation Requirements

- 1. Facility Operation Requirements.
  - a. The permittee shall operate this facility in accordance with Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., and Operation Permit No. 130542-007-SO/01 or its successors.

To construct a temporary stormwater management system within Cells 2, 3, and 4 of Phase II of a Class I landfill, referred to as the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC), Class I Landfill, subject to the specific and general conditions attached, located at the north end of Knights Trail Road, 2 miles east of I-75, northeast of Venice, Sarasota County, Florida. specific conditions attached are for the construction of:

A temporary stormwater management system within Cells 2-4 of the Phase II Class I landfill.

Replaces Permit No.:

N/A, new

This permit contains compliance items summarized in Attachment 1 that shall be complied with and submitted to the Department by the dates noted. If the compliance dates are not met and submittals are not received by the Department on the dates noted, enforcement action may be initiated to assure compliance with the conditions of this permit.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations and restrictions set forth in this permit, are "permit conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.141, 403.161, 403.727, or 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violation of these conditions.
- 2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
- 3. As provided in subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of rights, nor any infringement of federal, State, or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in this permit.
- 4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgment of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
- 5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
- 6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed and used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, are required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.
- 7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at reasonable times, access to the premises where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:
  - (a) Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under conditions of the permit;
  - (b) Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
  - (c) Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:
  - (a) A description of and cause of noncompliance; and
  - (b) The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the noncompliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

- 9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.
- 10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and Florida Statues after a reasonable time for compliance; provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or Department rules.
- 11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rule 62-4.120 and 62-730.300, Florida Administrative Code, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.
- 12. This permit or a copy thereof shall be kept at the work site of the permitted activity.
- 13. This permit also constitutes:
  - (a) Determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT)
  - (b) Determination of Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD)
  - (c) Certification of compliance with State Water Quality Standards (Section 40), PL 92-500)
  - (d) Compliance with New Source Performance Standards

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 14. The permittee shall comply with the following:
  - (a) Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.
  - (b) The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.
  - (c) Records of monitoring information shall include:
    - the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
    - 2. the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
    - 3. the dates analyses were performed;
    - 4. the person responsible for performing the analyses;
    - 5. the analytical techniques or methods used;
    - 6. the results of such analyses.
- 15. When requested by the Department, the permittee shall within a reasonable time furnish any information required by law which is needed to determine compliance with the permit. If the permittee becomes aware the relevant facts were not submitted or were incorrect in the permit application or in any report to the Department, such facts or information shall be corrected promptly.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -Solid Waste Facility General Requirements

- 1. **Facility Designation.** This site shall be classified as a Class I landfill and shall be constructed, operated, closed, monitored and maintained in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 62-4, 62-302, 62-330, 62-520, 62-522, 62-550, and 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and all applicable requirements of Department rules.
- 2. **Permit Application Documentation.** This permit is valid for **construction** of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill (including removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal), at the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex in accordance with Department rules and the reports, plans and other information prepared by SCS Engineers (unless otherwise specified) as follows:
  - a. Application for Construction/Minor Modification to Class I

    Operation Permit Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC)...

    (one 3-ring binder and plan set) dated January 19, 2012 (received January 23, 2012), as revised, replaced or amended (replacement pages inserted into original\*) dated March 2, 2012 (received March 5, 2012). This information includes, but is not limited to:
    - 1) Plan Set titled, <u>Sarasota County Central County Solid Waste</u>
      <u>Disposal Complex Stormwater Management System Improvements</u> (7
      Sheets) dated February 2012 (received March 5, 2012).
  - b. Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex Cells 1-4 of Phase II Class I Landfill Certification of Construction Completion Report, including Attachments A through F, received on February 12, 2010 and March 4, 2010, prepared by HDR Engineering, Inc. and Ardaman & Associates, Inc., as revised, replaced, or amended April 13, 2010 and May 26, 2010.

#### 3. Permit Modifications.

- a. Any construction or operation not previously approved as part of this permit shall require a separate Department permit unless the Department determines a permit modification to be more appropriate. Any significant changes to the construction or operation at the facility shall require a permit modification. Permits shall be modified in accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-4.080, F.A.C. A modification which is reasonably expected to lead to substantially different environmental impacts which require a detailed review by the Department is considered a substantial modification.
- b. This permit authorizes the construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill and the subsequent removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal, only.
- 4. **Permit Renewal. No later than March 1, 2017**, the permittee shall apply for a renewal of a permit on forms and in a manner prescribed by the Department, in order to assure conformance with all applicable Department rules. Permits shall be renewed at least every five years as required by Rule 62-701.320(10)(b), F.A.C.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -Solid Waste Facility General Requirements


- 5. **Professional Certification.** Where required by Chapter 471 (P.E.) or Chapter 492 (P.G.), Florida Statutes, applicable portions of permit applications and supporting documents which are submitted to the Department for public record shall be signed and sealed by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them.
- 6. **General Conditions.** The permittee shall be aware of and operate under the "General Conditions." General Conditions are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.
- 7. **Permit Acceptance.** By acceptance of this Permit, the Permittee certifies that he/she has read and understands the obligations imposed by the Specific and General Conditions contained herein and also including date of permit expiration and renewal deadlines. It is a violation of this permit for failure to comply with all conditions and deadlines.
- 8. **Regulations.** Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., effective January 6, 2010, is incorporated into this permit by reference. In the event that the regulations governing this permitted operation are revised, the Department shall notify the permittee, and the permittee shall request modification of those specific conditions which are affected by the revision of regulations to incorporate those revisions.
- 9. **Prohibitions.** The prohibitions of Rule 62-701.300, F.A.C., shall not be violated by the activities at this facility.
  - a. In the event that limestone is encountered during excavation or construction activities, the excavation/construction activities shall cease and the Department shall be notified within 24 hours of discovery. Written notification shall be submitted within 7 days of discovery. The written notification shall include the location, elevation, and extent of limestone noted on a plan sheet, a description of the materials encountered, and a plan of action which ensures that groundwater will not be adversely affected by the continued construction and operation of the facility. Excavation or construction activities shall not resume in the affected area until the Department-approved plan of action has been completed.
  - b. In the event that surface depressions or other occurrences which may be indicative of sinkhole activity or subsurface instability, are discovered on-site, or within 500 feet of the site, the Department shall be notified in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6.b. The written notification shall include a description of the incident, the location and size of the affected area shown on an appropriate plan sheet, and a corrective action plan which describes the actions necessary to prevent the unimpeded discharge of waste or leachate into ground or surface water.
  - c. Open burning of solid waste is prohibited except in accordance with Rule 62-701.300(3) and Chapter 62-256, F.A.C. All fires which require longer than one (1) hour to extinguish must be promptly reported to the Department in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6.b.

#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART B - Construction Requirements

- 1. **Construction.** All significant construction activities shall be approved by the Department prior to initiating work, unless specifically authorized otherwise.
  - a. This permit authorizes the construction of a temporary stormwater management system within the non-operating Cells 2-4 of Phase II of the Class I landfill and the subsequent removal of the system and restoration of the leachate collection system for each Cell prior to disposal.
- 2. **Certification of Construction Completion.** All information required by this Specific Condition shall be signed and sealed by a registered professional engineer or land surveyor as appropriate.
  - a. Within sixty (60) days after construction of the temporary stormwater system has been completed and <u>prior to</u> operation of the system, the following activities shall be completed and submitted by the permittee, and shall be approved by the Department:
    - 1) The owner or operator shall submit a Certification of Construction Completion, Form 62-701.900(2), signed and sealed by the professional engineer in charge of construction and quality assurance to the Department for approval, and shall arrange for Department representatives to inspect the construction in the company of the permittee, the engineer, and the facility operator.
    - 2) The owner or operator shall submit Record Drawings/Documents showing all changes (i.e. all additions, deletions, revisions to the plans previously approved by the Department including site grades and elevations). The Record Documents shall include asbuilt plans details and elevations (survey) as appropriate.
    - 3) The owner or operator shall submit a narrative indicating all changes in plans, the cause of the deviations, and certification of the Record Drawings/Documents by the Engineer to the Department.
    - 4) The professional engineer of record shall submit to the Department a final report to verify conformance with the plans and specifications in accordance with Rules 62-701.400(7) and (8), F.A.C.
  - b. Within sixty (60) days after construction completion and prior to disposal in each cell 2 through 4, the activities and information specified in Specific Condition #B.2.a. above, related to the removal of the temporary stormwater management system and restoration of the leachate collection system shall be completed and submitted by the permittee, and shall be approved by the Department:
- 3. Leachate Collection and Removal System.
  - a. Upon removal of the installed temporary stormwater management system in Cells 2-4, the leachate collection and removal system for each Cell shall be restored to its prior as-built conditions [ref. SC #A.2.b., above] unless otherwise specified by this permit.

### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - Operation Requirements

- Facility Operation Requirements.
  - a. The permittee shall operate this facility in accordance with Chapter 62-701, F.A.C., and Operation Permit No. 130542-007-SO/01 or its successors.
  - c. In no event shall waste be accepted for disposal in the Phase II, Cells 2-4 portion of the CCSWDC Class I landfill until the following requirements have been completed and submitted by the Permittee, and approved by the Department:
    - 1) Certification of Construction Completion requirements of Specific Conditions #B.2.b.
- 2. **Facility Personnel.** The owner or operator shall provide adequate personnel for constructing, operating, monitoring and maintaining the facility in an orderly, safe, and sanitary manner.
- 3. Control of Access. Access to, and use of, the facility shall be controlled as required by Rule 62-701.500(5), F.A.C.



#### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART D - Recordkeeping

1. **Report submittals.** Unless otherwise specified, all submittals, notifications, requests for permit modification, reports for compliance with this permit, etc. shall be sent to: Solid Waste Section, Department of Environmental Protection, Southwest District Office, 13051 North Telecom Parkway, Temple Terrace, Fl. 33637-0926.





  - a. Please provide a detailed explanation of how the 8" pipe will be installed through north berm. Please provide a CQA Plan for Alternate B and technical specification related to earthwork, directional drilling, and/or liner system installation and repair, as appropriate. The Department is concerned that either berm excavation or directional drilling through the berm will result in unwarranted damage to the installed liner system.
  - b. Please verify whether Alternate B was proposed to allow for simultaneous use of the leachate collection system in Cell 2 and the constructed Alternate B stormwater removal system. Under those circumstances, since Phase II has a double geomembrane liner system with and underlying GCL layer, an installed boot at the liner penetration appears to be inadequate to "seal the liner system". In particular, a boot on the primary liner would not seal the underlying leak detection geocomposite, secondary liner, or GCL layer at the pipe penetration and therefore will not prevent leachate leakage through the liner penetration from the leak detection system. Please verify and address this concern.


