Volusia County - SW/WT Waste Tire Removal Program

Dear Mr. Grusauskas:

Many Florida counties, including yours, are currently under a medical alert for two potentially serious diseases, namely West Nile Virus (WNV) and Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE). Both diseases can be communicated to humans by mosquito species known to breed in waste tire piles. The purpose of this letter is to request your support and advise you of assistance that the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is willing to offer to remove and process waste tire piles from our communities.

We are asking for your cooperation in a program to remove and process as many waste tire piles in our communities as possible. The program will have 4 steps.

- 1. Identifying and prioritizing waste tire piles. From reports of tire piles by citizens and county staff, DEP will compile a list of tire piles, inspect the piles, estimate the quantity of waste tires, and set priorities for pile removal. DEP and county staff will contact the responsible party to determine if they are willing and able to remove the waste tires from the site.
- 2. Amnesty Day Program—Counties may request support for amnesty days to allow local residents to remove small quantities of tires from local properties. The county will be responsible for: (1) requesting assistance from DEP for a specific time interval and estimated quantity of tires so that DEP can make necessary contractor arrangements; (2) designating a secure and monitored collection site for receipt of quantities of up to 25 tires per delivery by local residents; and (3) seeing that these tires are efficiently loaded into trailers located at these sites. DEP will use and pay for; its contractors to transport process and properly use or dispose of the tires.

3. Small Site Assistance—Counties may request assistance in cleaning up specifically identified sites containing less than 5,000 tires, subject to prioritization and prior approval by DEP. Tires from very small pre-approved sites (less than 1,000 tires) will have to be transported to a designated collection site and loaded onto transport trailers by the landowner, responsible party or county. The landowner and/or responsible party must sign an agreement not to accumulate additional tires in exchange for the state waiving cost recovery for transport and disposal costs for as long as the agreement is honored.

Tires from larger sites (up to 5,000 tires) may be considered by DEP for similar treatment under appropriate conditions, or trailers may be placed at a pre-approved site for loading by the responsible party or the county. DEP will bear the cost of transport and disposal for pre-approved quantities of tires.

4. Large Site Assistance-State, county and local enforcement groups will coordinate efforts to identify larger sites (over 5,000 tires) and encourage cleanup by the responsible parties. If the responsible party is unable or unwilling to abate the site promptly, site access will be requested in writing so that DEP or the county can abate the site. DEP will use its contractors, or alternative cooperative efforts with the county, and will follow our normal procedures to clean up these sites.

For this program to be effective, teamwork is essential. State and local governments and individual citizens must be willing to participate. Please agree to help us make an impact on this problem by providing an appropriate contact person in Volusia County to coordinate with DEP staff. MEDICAL ALERT FOR WEST NILE VIRUS EXTENDED TO INCLUDE CITRUS, COLLIER, DESOTO, GLADES, HARDEE, HENDRY, HIGHLANDS, MARTIN, OKEECHOBEE AND ST. LUCIE COUNTIES

TALLAHASSEE—Due to West Nile (WN) virus detection in birds and other animals, Florida Department of Health Secretary John O. Agwunobi, M.D., M.B.A., today placed Citrus, Collier, DeSoto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands, Martin, Okeechobee and St. Lucie counties on medical alert. The following 34 counties are now under medical alert: Alachua, Brevard, Charlotte, Citrus, Collier, DeSoto, Escambia, Flagler, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Hernando, Highlands, Hillsborough, Indian River, Lake, Lee, Manatee, Marion, Martin, Okeechobee, Orange, Osceola, Palm Beach, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, Putnam, Sarasota, Seminole, St. Johns, St. Lucie, Sumter and Volusia counties.

"With the addition of these 10 counties, over half our state is now under medical alert for West Nile virus. However, everyone in our state, regardless of whether their particular county is under medical alert, should be diligent about taking precautionary measures," said Agwunobi. "The most effective way to prevent getting mosquito-borne diseases is to continue taking precautionary measures to avoid being bitten."


Agwunobi recommends people take the following precautionary measures:

- Avoid outdoor activities when mosquitoes are active, especially at dusk and dawn;
- If you must be outdoors when mosquitoes are active, cover up by wearing shoes, socks, long pants and a long-sleeved shirt. Additional protection can be obtained by applying permethrin repellent directly to clothing;
- For adults and children older than two months of age, the best protection is achieved by using
 mosquito repellent containing 30 percent DEET (N,N-Diethyl-meta-toluamide also called N,Ndiethyl-3-methylbenzamide) according to manufacturer's directions. Greater concentrations
 provide no additional benefits and risk increased incidence of side effects. For children younger
 than two months of age DEET is not recommended; use protective clothing and cover with
 mosquito netting; and
- Eliminate stagnant water in birdbaths, ponds and other receptacles in which mosquitoes might breed by emptying or changing.

The Department of Health laboratories provide testing services for physicians treating patients with clinical signs of mosquito-borne (arboviral) disease. These signs may include headache, fever, fatigue, dizziness, weakness and confusion. Physicians should submit serum and, if available, cerebrospinal fluid samples to either the Tampa or Jacksonville Department of Health laboratories. People over the age of 50 are at the greatest risk of having severe disease from an arbovirus infection.

DOH continues to conduct statewide surveillance for arboviruses, including West Nile (WN) virus, Eastern Equine Encephalomyelitis (EEE) and St. Louis Encephalitis (SLE). Residents of Florida are encouraged to report dead birds by calling the West Nile Virus Hotline at 1-800-871-9703, or via the Web site www.wildflorida.org/bird/. 


