Explanation: As a result of the findings of the 1st Semi-Annual 2016 Water Quality Monitoring Report

and subsequent confirmation sampling results, exceedances of groundwater standards were confirmed at TH-67. This well is located near the southeast corner of Phase II, extends to the surficial aquifer, and has been designated as a detection well. The parameters of interest are pH, total dissolved solids (TDS), chloride, and sodium.

Update for 2017 Inspection: The County continues to assess water quality impacts in the area surrounding TH-67. The County has installed additional monitoring locations (TH-79, 80, 81 and 82) and is conducting supplemental quarterly sampling at these plus existing locations to monitor impacts associated with elevated leachate levels within the Phases I-VI landfill in accordance with Paragraph 9.g of Consent Agreement OGC No.

17-0058. The most recent supplement event, sampled May 2017 indicates

exceedances of a primary drinking water standard, Sodium at TH-67, TH-79, and TH-81, and of secondary drinking water standards, TDS and Chloride, at TH-67, TH-79, TH-81 and TDS at TH-80. TH-67 and TH-79 are detection wells located ~50 feet from the edge of waste. TH-80 and TH-81 are located at the edge of the zone of discharge

(100' ZOD) for Phase I-VI.

Corrective Action: The County shall initiate evaluation monitoring in accordance with Rule 62-

701.500(6)(a), F.A.C. at monitoring wells TH-67, TH-79, TH-80, and TH-81 upon receipt of this letter in addition to the requirements of Paragraph 10 of the Consent Agreement OGC No. 17-0058. Additionally, since contaminants which exceed Department water quality standards have been verified at the zone of discharge, the County shall also initiate corrective actions in accordance with Rule 62-701.500(6)(c), F.A.C. at affected

locations.
