The above referenced facility has experienced no changes the management of waste tires and is operating in compliance with the permit requirements. The maximum quantity of tires allowed to be stored on site is 80.4 tons. The anticipated disposal cost for the maximum storage quantity is calculated as follows:

2016 Disposal Cost Estimate = \$4,960.02 FDEP Inflation Multiplier 2017 = 1.019 2017 Disposal Cost Estimate (1.019 x \$4,960.02) = \$5,054.26 Current Bond Amount - \$10,000.00, Hartford Bond No. 13BSBFQ9243
