Good morning Mr. West,

In response to yesterday's phone call, I reviewed the financial compliance file for Global Tire. The Department approved the 2011 financial cost estimate update on March 17, 2011 (letter attached). The financial cost estimate is an estimate of closure costs based on disposal of the maximum quantity of tires permitted to be stored at the facility and any miscellaneous costs associated with facility closure. The cost estimate provided with the permit renewal had some of the numbers inadvertently misplaced on the cost estimate spreadsheet. The itemized corrections to the cost estimate are as follows:


1. The inside and outside storage bins, Areas H1 - H3, are considered finished crumb rubber inventory and as such is not considered to be waste product but rather saleable product. Therefore, the change on the spreadsheet shows a reduction of Waste Tires & Processed Tires by 185 + 150 tons, and Crumb Rubber in Super Sacks shows an increase of 185 + 150 tons. Note that the saleable materials are removed at no charge.
2. The Wire Pile, Area J3, is also considered as saleable product as it can be recycled. Again, this material will be removed at no charge. Therefore, Residual Derived Waste is reduced by 45 tons and a separate cost category for Wire Pile is added.

Also attached is an updated letter from Liberty Waste Services outlining their costs.



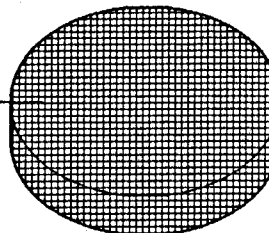

Please find enclosed a Permit Renewal & Modification package for the above referenced site. Included in the package are the Waste Tire Processing Facility Permit Application (DEP Form: 62-701.900(23)), a Site Plan with the proposed modifications, an Addendum of Operations Plan, and a check for \$1,250.00.

Pursuant to Part III - Attachments, facility design drawings (A) are included. Floor plan drawings have not changed since the previous submittal. Facility operations documents (B) have also not changed since the previous submittals, with the exception of the included Addendum and Site Plan. Pursuant to Section C, financial assurance information is included.

The modifications to the plan are all for storage and staging of materials to be processed or materials that have been processed. The modifications are made to make the movement of these materials easier and to make the storage and staging more manageable. Additionally, with these storage and staging areas expanded, it will make emergency egress in and around the manufacturing building safer for the permittee's employees, as well as further promote fire safety.

The modification on the east side of the office building, in the parking lot, will require the reduction of parking spaces. Therefore, this part of the modification was submitted to the City of Wildwood for their review in November. The City of Wildwood has approved the reconfiguration of the parking lot based on local requirements. The approval letter is included herewith.

associated with the closure plan have been identified and prepaid. The following assumptions underly Global's closing plan and financial assurances:

**1. Whole Tires**

There will be a maximum of 190 tons of whole tires on the premises in trailers, moving zone piles and hoppers. They will be removed by an agreement with Recovery Technologies Group, Inc. at a cost of \$30/ton. This letter agreement dated February 19, 2003 is attached.

**2. Processed Tires**

There will be a maximum of 1,206 tons of processed tires, which consists mainly of saleable crumb rubber finished products. If they cannot be sold, they will be removed by Recovery Technologies Group, Inc. for \$30/ton as part of the above agreement.

**3. Residuals**

There will be a maximum of 11, 30 CY equivalent dumpsters that will contain metal/rubber and fiber/rubber residual material. They will be removed by Waste Management at a cost of \$244.00 each. There will be one 30 CY dumpster of office waste that will be removed by WM for \$566.00 per an Agreement dated February 20, 2003 that is attached.

The Emergency Preparedness Manual is on file with the Department as Rev. 8/27/99 and updated pages on 11/20/02.

**7. A Copy of the Fire Safety Survey.**

Copies of Global's Annual Fire Safety Surveys are on file with the Department, with the most recent one being transmitted on 11/20/02.

**8. A Description of How 75% of the Annual Accumulation of Waste Tires will Be Removed for Disposal or Recycling.**

For the past four years of full-scale production, Global has had 100% of its annual accumulation of waste tires "removed" via processing them into recycled saleable crumb rubber and residual. The residuals have been disposed by Waste Management to their Bayside Landfill in Ocala. This will continue to be the process for disposing of waste tires.

**C. COMPLETED CLOSING PLAN FOR THE FACILITY AS REQUIRED BY RULE 62-711.700(2) AND (3), F.A.C.**

In closing the facility, Global will stop access to the site; post a notice indicating the site is closed and the location of the nearest waste tire processing facility where waste tires can be deposited; notify the Department and Sumter County of the closing; remove all waste tires, processed tires and residuals to a waste tire processing facility, solid waste management facility authorized to accept waste tires or a legitimate user of processed tires; remove any solid waste to a permitted solid waste management facility and notify the Department when the closure is complete.

The Department will be given at least 60 days written notice prior to closure. Such notification will give the Department the opportunity to inspect the facility and determine whether any other procedures shall be followed as part of the closure. Any such directives shall be followed. No waste tires will be accepted within 15 days prior to the date that closure will begin. Global will complete closure on the site in accordance with approved closure plan with 180 days after receiving the final quantity of waste tires. Global must provide proof of financial assurance that all expenses

associated with the closure plan have been identified and prepaid. The following assumptions underly Global's closing plan and financial assurances:

**1. Whole Tires**

There will be a maximum of 190 tons of whole tires on the premises in trailers, moving zone piles and hoppers. They will be removed by an agreement with Recovery Technologies Group, Inc. at a cost of \$30/ton. This letter agreement dated February 19, 2003 is attached.

**2. Processed Tires**

There will be a maximum of 1,206 tons of processed tires, which consists mainly of saleable crumb rubber finished products. If they cannot be sold, they will be removed by Recovery Technologies Group, Inc. for \$30/ton as part of the above agreement.

**3. Residuals**

There will be a maximum of 11, 30 CY equivalent dumpsters that will contain metal/rubber and fiber/rubber residual material. They will be removed by Waste Management at a cost of \$244.00 each. There will be one 30 CY dumpster of office waste that will be removed by WM for \$566.00 per an Agreement dated February 20, 2003 that is attached.



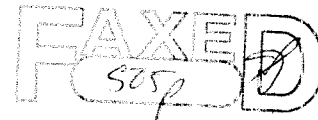

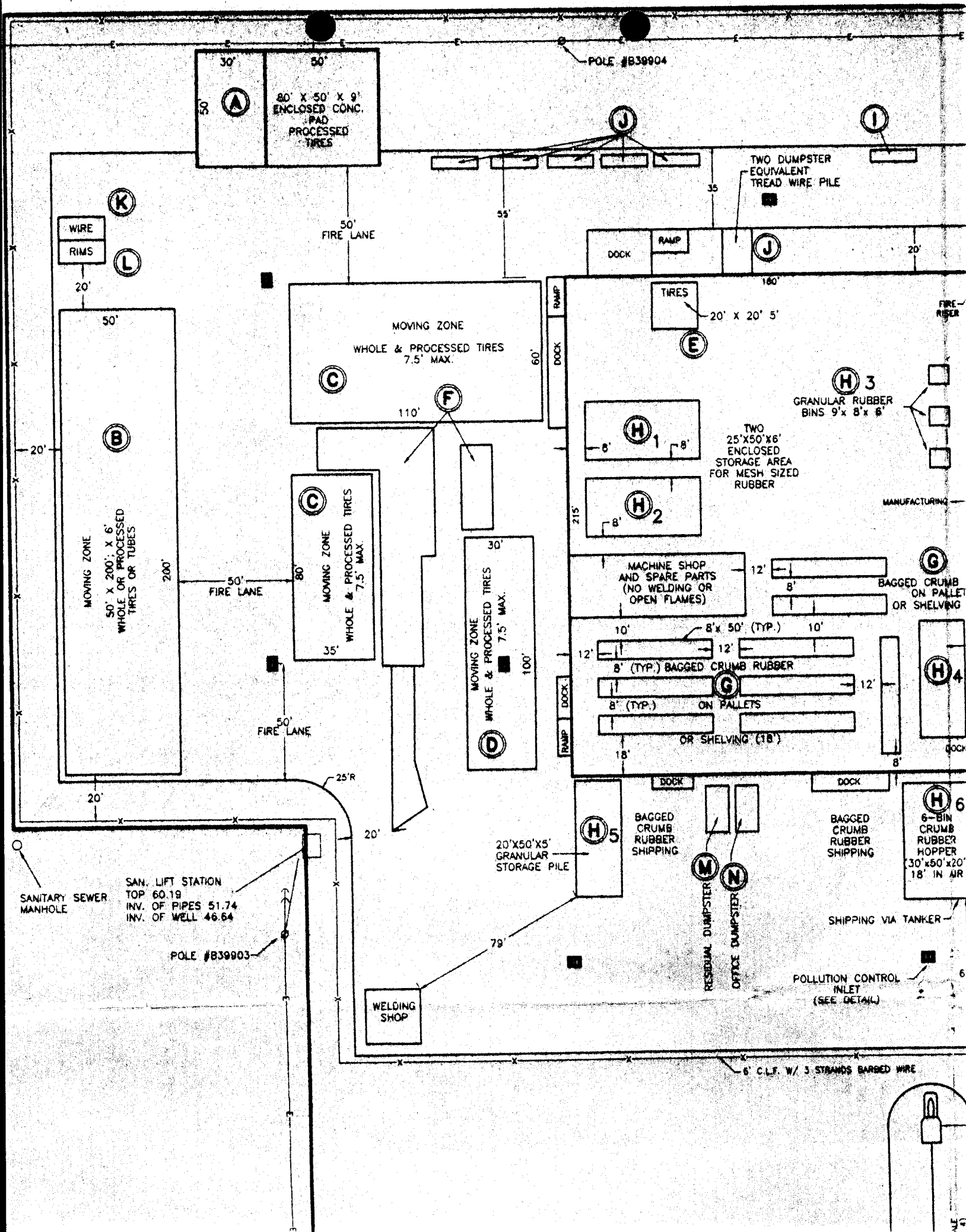

Global Tire Recycling hereby withdraws its request to modify the above referenced Permit.



In accordance with F.A.C. 62-711.500(3), Global Tire Recycling hereby provides an inflation-adjusted cost estimate for closure of its Waste Tire Processing Facility.

The \$73,277 cost estimate that was approved on April 14, 2000 for the year 2000 was based on the following inflation-adjusted data: \$40.80 per ton to remove rubber (1606 tons) and \$540.60 to remove a dumpster of other solid waste (14 dumpsters).

While these unit costs remain unchanged, Global hereby provides 1.6% inflation-adjusted unit costs of \$41.45 and \$549.25, respectively. When applied to the current Storage Plan quantities, it produces a closure cost estimate of \$74,258.20. When applied to the proposed Storage Plan that currently is under review, it produces a closure cost estimate of \$74,983.50.



In accordance with F.A.C. 62-711.500(3), Global Tire Recycling hereby provides an inflation-adjusted cost estimate for closure of its Waste Tire Processing Facility.

The \$73,277 cost estimate that was approved on April 11, 2000 for the year 2000 was based on the following inflation-adjusted data: \$40.80 per ton to remove rubber (1606 tons) and \$540.60 to remove a dumpster of other solid waste (14 dumpsters).

While these unit costs remain unchanged, Global hereby provides 1.6% inflation-adjusted unit costs of \$41.45 and \$549.25, respectively. When applied to the current Storage Plan quantities, it produces a closure cost estimate of \$74,258.20. When applied to the proposed Storage Plan that currently is under review, it produces a closure cost estimate of \$74,983.50.
