This section provides a completed closing plan for the facility as required by Rule 62-711.700(2) and (3), F.A.C.

Proof of financial responsibility as required by Rule 62-711.500(3) sufficient to assure closing of the waste tire site will be provided for the removal of up to 80.4 tons of waste tires, after final storage quantities are established through this permitting process.

When the facility is no longer going to function as a waste tire facility, the plant personnel will deny access of waste tire collectors to the facility. A notice will be posted at the entrance to the property indicating that the waste tire processing facility is closed and giving the phone number of the county solid waste authority. The cost estimate is the amount that would be expended to load, transport, and dispose of waste tires on the site.
