The inspection of the Waste Tire Processing Facility by Pasco County Fire Rescue is attached. All of the items listed in the inspection report are in the process of being addressed . I will ask for the Fire Inspector to re-inspect the facility prior to their 5/21/18 deadline. We will forward that re-inspection to you.

We have placed additional initial cover over all area of the landfill such that there is no exposed wood ash. I've attached pictures of the additional soil/mulch cover. We have address all areas of erosion, initial cover maintenance, and wood ash exposure listed in the inspection.
