Thank you for your application for Waste Tire Processing facility submitted on November 30, 2018 for the above referenced Site. A review of your application and supporting documentation indicates the application is incomplete. Please provide the information listed below and refer to this RAI in your response. The response to this RAI must be signed, sealed, and dated by a registered Florida Professional Engineer.

- 1. The Waste Tire Removal and Disposal Letter (section C) from Tropical Tire and Auto Service Inc. is dated 2013. Please submit an updated letter. The letter must have the following:
 - a) Agreement with the rest of the application in the amount of tires to be disposed.
 - b) A statement that the cost provided includes pickup, hauling and disposal of the tires.
 - c) The agreement should be valid for the duration of the permit (5 years). (Rule 62-701.630(4)(b))
- 2. The Fire Survey (section B (6)) was not included in the submittal. Please submit an updated Fire Survey. (Rule 62-711.540(1)(d))

To continue the processing of your application, the Department must receive a response within 90 days of this letter, March 20, 2019, unless a written request for additional time to provide the requested information is submitted and approved. It is the Department's desire to provide prompt turnaround times on permit applications, and a quicker response to this RAI shortens the timeframe for which a final decision on the application can be made. Pursuant to Rule 62-4.050, F.A.C. and Section 120.60, F.S., failure of an applicant to provide timely requested information by the applicant deadline may result in denial of the application. You are encouraged to contact this office to discuss the items requested to assist you in developing a complete and adequate response.
