The Environmental Permitting Section (EPS) of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources (RER)-Division of Environmental Resources Management (DERM), under delegation by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (hereafter jointly referred to as the Department), hereby acknowledges receipt of the referenced applications on March 12, 2019 and offers the following comment(s):

1. The referenced FDEP permit application was received without the required application processing fee. Be advised that Rule 62-4.050(5), Florida Administrative Code, requires that when an application is received without the required fee, the Department shall acknowledge receipt of the application and shall notify the applicant by certified mail that the required fee was not received and advise the applicant of the correct fee. The Department shall take no further action until the applicable processing fee in the amount listed below is received. If the applicant does not submit the required fee **within ten (10) days** of receipt of written notification, the Department shall either return the unprocessed application or arrange with the applicant for the pick up of the application. Upon receipt of the proper application fee, the permit processing time requirements of Sections 120.60(1) and 403.0876, Florida Statutes (F.S.), shall begin.
2. The referenced RRMF permit application was received without the required application processing fee. The Department shall take no further action until the applicable processing fee in the amount listed below is received. If the applicant does not submit the required fee **within ten (10) days** of receipt of written notification, the Department shall either return the unprocessed application or arrange with the applicant for the pick up of the application. Upon receipt of the proper fee, the Department shall commence the review of the RRMF application.
