Dear Mr. Tafuni:

On May 24, 2019, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) conducted a compliance site inspection at the Hillsborough County (County) Southeast County Landfill (SCLF). A follow up meeting was conducted on August 1, 2019 between the Hillsborough County Solid Waste Management Division (SWMD) and FDEP in accordance with the Corrective Action described within the Inspection Letter Question Number 1.6 corrective action.

In that meeting, SWMD agreed to investigate the localized stormwater runoff near groundwater monitoring well TH-71A. SWMD agreed to remove accumulated sediment from the terrace swale upslope of TH-71A and to regrade adjacent stormwater conveyance features. The corrective actions will promote drainage and abate ponding that influences groundwater parameters in TH-71A.

The SWMD has removed approximately one foot of accumulated sediment from the stormwater swale immediately adjacent (upslope) to TH-71A and replaced it with silty sand from the Soil Borrow Area. Additionally, the SWMD has conducted surficial grading to promote drainage in the upslope swale and the downslope drainage area. Photographs of the remediated areas are included as attachments to this letter.
