On behalf of Manatee County, SCS Engineers (SCS) prepared this letter to notify the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) of a detection of total dissolved solids (TDS) of 581 milligrams per liter (mg/L) exceeding the secondary drinking water standard of 500 mg/L, in monitoring well GW-19 at the Lena Road Landfill. This exceedance occurred during the second 2019 routine semiannual water quality monitoring event. TDS was detected during the confirmation monitoring event at a concentration of 644 mg/L.

This is a first time exceedance of TDS in well GW-19 and the results have been confirmed. In accordance with Appendix 3, Condition 4 of Permit No. 39884-021-SO-01, SCS is notifying FDEP of this first time exceedance.
