Only pertinent information from the reports is included in the waste tire report. This data includes Tires In, Tires Out, and Illegal Dumping – Tires. They are defined as follows:

- Tires In: Tires delivered to the Landfill by the general public.
- Tires Out: Tires which are removed from the waste tire storage area by the County's contracted vendor for processing.
- Illegal Dumping Tires: Tires that are illegally dumped within Manatee County then subsequently picked up and delivered to the Landfill by various public agencies.

All tires delivered to the Landfill are stockpiled and subsequently removed from the site by a contracted vendor. No processing or consumption of tires occurs at the Landfill. Therefore, processed, adjusted and consumed tires have been recorded as zero. All other tire categories have been entered where appropriate. All tires recorded for this report are considered used tires.
