Dear Mr. Vargas:

A complaint inspection was conducted at your facility on January 27, 2021. During the inspection and subsequent file review, possible violations of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Chapters 62-701 and 62-711, Florida Administrative Code were observed.

During the inspection Department personnel noted the following:

- The facility is storing greater than 1,500 tires on-site and is operating a Waste Tire Processing Facility without a Department Solid Waste Permit authorization.

Violations of Florida Statutes or administrative rules may result in liability for damages and restoration, and the judicial imposition of civil penalties, pursuant to section 403.161 Florida Statutes.

Current Violations:

Rule: 62-701.300(1)(a)

Question Number: 13.1

Explanation: During the January 27, 2021 inspection, Department staff observed that the facility was storing greater than 1,500 tires on-site and was processing waste tires (de-rimmed, doubling and packaging tires for shipment overseas) without a Department Solid Waste Permit authorization. A review of Department files, performed on February 23, 2021, indicates that a Compliance Assistance Site Visit (CASV) was conducted at the facility on March 15, 2018. During the CASV, the owner, Mr. Vargas, was notified of the requirement to obtain a Waste Tire Processing Facility (WTPF) permit for the RJ Tires facility. An application for a WTPF permit was submitted to the Department on March 1, 2020. However, the application remains incomplete due to the applicant's difficulty in obtaining financial assurance in the amount of the provided closure cost estimate for the facility.

Corrective Action: Robert and Sons Tire Corporation has knowingly operated a Waste Tire Processing Facility without a Department Solid Waste Permit authorization for three years following the Department's 2018 CASV. The storage and processing of waste tires at the above referenced site is not authorized and must cease operations until a Waste Tire Processing Permit is obtained. Per the attached Warning Letter, (#WL21-41SW53SWD), please contact the Department within 7 days its receipt to schedule a meeting to discuss these matters.
