This letter is to acknowledge receipt of inflation-adjusted cost estimates, dated and received March 4, 2021, for closure of the CEMEX Brooksville South Cement Plant Alternative Fuel Material Processing Facility. The cost estimates received March 4, 2021 (total for closing \$336,944.12) are **APPROVED for 2021**. This estimate is for disposal of 5200 tons of alternative fuel material. The next annual update (revised or inflation-adjusted estimates) is due no later than **March 1, 2022**.

Dear Ms. Wargo:

The above referenced facility was issued Permit No. 22787-006-SO/31 on December 17th, 2018. There are no changes regarding the management of alternative fuels. The facility is currently operating in compliance with the permit requirements. Storage of Tire Fluff was not properly stored during parts of 2020 (too close to edge of building), this issue has been corrected, employees retrained, signage for storage limits posted. The maximum quantity of alternative fuel storage is 5200 tons. The anticipated disposal cost for the maximum storage quantity is calculated as follows:

2020 Disposal Cost Estimate = \$331,311.82
FDEP Inflation Multiplier **2021** = 1.017
2021 Disposal Cost Estimate (1.017 x \$331,311.82) = \$336,944.12
Current Bond Amount - \$350,000, Travelers Bond No. 106077080
