This is to acknowledge receipt of the additional information dated November 19, 2008 and December 11, 2008 (received November 19, 2008 and December 12, 2008) submitted in support of your permit renewal application dated July 21, 2008 (received July 24, 2008) prepared by PBS&J, to continue operation of a waste tire processing facility (WTPF) referred to as the Lena Road Waste Tire Facility, located at 3333 Lena Road, Bradenton, Manatee County, Florida.

This letter constitutes notice that a permit will be required for your project pursuant to Chapter(s) 403, Florida Statutes. Your application for permit modification is incomplete. This is the Department's third request for information. Please provide the information listed below promptly. Evaluation of your proposed project will be delayed until all requested information has been received.

The following information is needed in support of the solid waste permit application [Chapter 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)].

  - a. Part I, Section A, Item 7. No additional information is requested for this item.

  - c. Part I, Section B, Items 8 & 9. Please clarify that until the construction of the new facility is certified complete by the Department, it will not be used. Please be advised that the construction should be certified complete prior to the issuance of the WTPF operation permit renewal, as once this permit is issued the WTPF will have to be moved into the new location.
  - d. Part II, Section F. No additional information is requested for this item.
  - e. Part III, Section A, Item 1. No additional information is requested for this item.

  - a. <u>Section 2.2</u> Please submit a narrative for this section which is consistent with the construction drawings submitted December 19, 2008. **See comment #6 below.**
  - b. <u>Section 2.7</u> No additional information is requested for this item.

Please submit plans sheets showing the remaining cross section details, C through I. Sheet C-14 references the detail for a concrete flume, which is not shown. Please provide the sheets between C-14 & C-17 in the plan set.

Please respond by January 16, 2008, responding to all of the information requests and indicating when a response to any unanswered questions will be submitted. If the response will require longer than the date noted above, you should develop an alternate specific time table for the submission of the requested information for Department review and consideration. Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C., if the Department does not receive a timely, complete response to this request for information the Department may issue a final order denying your application. A denial for lack of information or response will be unbiased as to the merits of the application. The applicant may reapply as soon as the requested information is available.
