Dear Mr. Campagna:

Enclosed are Permit Numbers SC48-0165969-008 & SO48-0165969-009 (Modification of Permit No. SC48-0165969-007), to modify the current Class III landfill permit to incorporate the expansion of the landfill, issued under Section(s) 403.061(14) and 403.707, of the Florida Statutes.

At the request of the Engineer of Record, and to make this permit consistent with the Environmental Resource Permit Application, Specific Condition 6 has been modified to require that solid waste shall not be placed below elevation 75 feet NGVD rather than 73 feet NGVD. Specific Condition 6 now reads as follows:

6. Final Grade Plan: The final grade plan is shown on Sheet 3 of 5 of the construction plans submitted with the permit application referenced as No. 1 of the documents listed in Appendix A. Solid waste shall not be placed below elevation **75** feet NGVD. The maximum elevation including final cover shall not exceed an elevation of 50 feet above existing site grades.


Any party to this order (permit) has the right to seek judicial review of the permit under section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal under rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection, Office of General Counsel, Mail Station 35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice of appeal must be filed within thirty days after this notice is filed with the Clerk of the Department.
