Specific Condition: C.6 Facility Maintenance and Repair

Dear Ms. Pelz:

On Thursday, March 11, 2010, the Citrus County Central Landfill experienced a rain fall event measuring 5.63" within a two-hour period. The rainfall event caused significant erosional issues which impacted intermediately covered areas. This letter shall serve as the required 7-day written notification following my verbal notification of March 11, 2010.

A mitigating factor which may have contributed to the erosion is the on-going installation of the landfill gas collection system. As necessitated by the construction and installation of the piping system significant portions of the landfill have been disturbed. While these areas are immediately re-covered upon completion of daily work, they have not had the opportunity to stabilize. Therefore, the recently disturbed intermediate cover, when exposed to a torrential down pour resulted in significant erosion.

Crews stayed late on March 11th, and came in early on March 12th to make initial repairs to the intermediate cover in compliance with Specific Condition C.6.e. We are making improvements to our initial repairs in order to prevent reoccurrence; these improvements should be completed by March 19, 2010.
