Dear Mr. Robinson:

Florida Tire Recycling, Inc. is required to comply with Item 10.D.5. by July 13, 1994. Thus, Florida Tire, Inc. shall remove all whole and shredded tires from the FPL easement by that date. The removal of this material is not dependent upon the issuance of a Department permit. If there is any question, let me reiterate that the Stipulation authorized this activity, so Section 10.L. is not applicable. Furthermore, the FPL letter attached to your April 11th letter suggests that FPL will not approve any further plans until the tires and shreds are removed from the easement.

Please take whatever measures are necessary to comply with the terms of the Stipulation.

I trust this clarifies this matter.

Dear Mr. Robinson:

We have received the referenced letter via facsimile. I presume you mean to call my attention to Section 10.D-5, which specifically refers to removal of whole and shredded tires from the FPL easement. You are correct in noting the error in our letter; the correct deadline for removal of this material is July 13, 1994. However, your reference to Section L is puzzling. The removal of material from the FPL easement is a strict requirement of the Stipulation and is not dependent on the issuance of DEP permits or authorization.

We are in receipt of the above captioned. I write to call your attention to the statement made on the top of page 2, "the shredded tire piles in the FPL easement are required to be relocated and moved from this easement not later than June 14, 1994."

Based on our reading of the Stipulation entered on January 13, 1994, FTR believes that there is an error in your June 14, 1994 date (see Section D6 and Section L).

Since these are important dates in the time line established in the Stipulation, I would appreciate your early attention and response to this issue.
