

Dear Secretary of the D.E.R.,

We hereby authorize you to draw on First National Bank and Trust Company of the Treasure Coast for the account of Florida Tire Recycling, Inc. up to the aggregate amount of Fifteen Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00) by means of your sight draft on us accompanied by:
