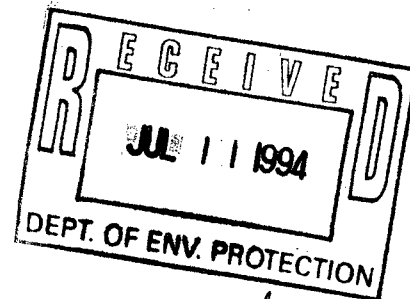

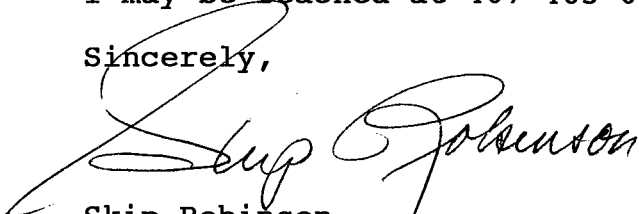

EXHIBIT A

MATERIAL REMOVAL AND SITE RECONFIGURATION:

1. During the period 06/01/94 through 06/30/94 and as the summary page indicates, FLORIDA TIRE RECYCLING, INC. (FTR) successfully removed 4139.23 tons. During this same period FTR collected 1842.04 tons. Based on a 22 collection day month, the Base Removal Amount (BRA) for the period is $(2200 + 1842.04)$ 4042.04 tons.

Thus, FTR exceeded the BRA for the month of June by 97.19 tons. As a result, for the entire period of the Stipulation commencing on January 14, 1994 through June 30, 1994 the **Company has exceeded the BRA by 1,463.25 tons.**

2. Fire lanes required to be in place by June 23 (FL5, FL6, FL7) have been completed. As in the past fire lanes are subject to some shredded material remaining on the surface of the roadways (see summary for the month of May Exhibit A, paragraph 2 for complete explanation).

3. All shred piles have been lowered below 15 feet.

4. On or about June 21, 1994 FTR began creating 50' x 150' x 15' storage piles in the "loop road" storage area. Each pile is separated from the perimeter of the property and from another pile of rubber by at least 50'. Three piles have been so constructed: one contains shreds; the other 2 contain oversized, off-road tires.

5. By the close of the month approximately 60% of the material that had been lying in the FP&L easement had been removed from that easement and either stored elsewhere on the site (see above), reprocessed for fuel (TDF) or disposed of at ORANGE WASTE RECYCLING & MATERIALS, INC.

As part of the removal of this material, the location for the "wet detention area" has been substantially cleared of waste tire material and is now ready for excavation upon receipt of the MSSW permit.

6. This month the County returned to continue cleaning the swale at Range Line Road. However, during the month and especially around the period of June 17 through June 20, 1994 the Company sustained serious back flooding onto its property from the swale.

ENGINEERING AND PERMIT APPLICATIONS:

1. On June 1, 1994 representatives of the Company attended a meeting with representatives of the Department to discuss the fines and penalties to be issued by the Department for alleged dredge and fill violations. Subsequently, on June 19th FTR received a Consent Order proposed by the Department. FTR has sent this document to its consultants (attorney and biologist) for an evaluation and response.

2. In connection with the Company's continuing effort, begun in January 1993, to obtain a Waste Tire Processing Permit for its Lakeland site, on June 6, 1994 FTR received a letter from Kim Ford, PE of the SOUTHWEST DISTRICT requesting further information from the SOUTHEAST DISTRICT regarding FTR's Compliance with the Stipulation. FTR has been told repeatedly by Joe Lurix of the SOUTHEAST DISTRICT that he is unable to respond to this request, since he has been advised by Attorney Bowman that to respond to the request would violate the Stipulation.

It appears that the SOUTHWEST DISTRICT will not issue until Mr. Ford receives this one final piece of information. Therefore, FTR remains in a "catch 22" caught between the two Districts in its attempt to secure the Lakeland permit which at the time the Stipulation was entered was reported to be forthcoming.

Since without a processing permit for Lakeland, the tires received at FTR's Lakeland facility must be brought to Port St. Lucie, the delay in receiving the permit to process waste tires collected at the Lakeland site has caused an unexpected financial burden on FTR as it complies with the accelerated removal mandated in the Stipulation.

EXHIBIT B

FIRE EQUIPMENT: EQUIPMENT AND TRAINING

1. On June 6, 1994 FTR met at the site with Joe Lurix of the Department to witness a training session conducted by Mike Gablemann of the ST LUCIE COUNTY/FT. PIERCE FIRE DEPARTMENT. This demonstration included the use of the foam equipment recently installed on FTR's all wheel drive tank wagon trucks.

EXHIBIT C

TRUST FUND:

1. There has been no change in the Trust Fund other than that it has grown by one month's interest since the last summary. The Fund now stands at approximately \$50,149.

In accordance with the Stipulation there are no additional monies required to be deposited into this account until the end of the month which commences with July 14, 1994.

2. During the reporting period covered here, FTR contacted the FIRST NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY and requested that it begin implementing the transfer of the \$15,000 Letter of Credit held at that Bank into the Trust Fund, which will bring the total in the Fund to \$65,000 plus interest.
