Dear Mr. Kahn,

I am writing to confirm the clarification of several questions that developed as a result of implementing the Stipulation

1. For those vendors which either deliver or remove tires (or shredded material) from the site who do not have DEP collector decals and numbers, FTR is instructed to record their vehicle VIN.
2. You have confirmed that the monthly summary report is to be done on a calendar month basis. Therefore the reporting for January is to be made on February 10, 1994 and will cover the period from the date the Stipulation was entered, January 14, 1994, through the end of the month, January 31, 1994. Thereafter, the monthly report will be due on the 10th of the following month. For example, on March 10, 1994 the report will be due for all activities covered by the Stipulation for the period February 1, through February 28, 1994.

You have confirmed that under Section 4, the report shall include the tonnage of waste tires brought on and removed from the site; the volume issue applies only to: (1) those disposal sites which accept the shredded material in terms of yards; (2) when tires are transported from the site for recapping or resale.
