Details of Conversation:

The Department received a faxed complaint from Mr. Blackman on 12/2/05. His complaint requested an investigation of his former employer, Partridge Sibley Industrial Services located on the property of International Paper Company in Cantonment due to contamination of soil and violations of the Clean Air Act (attached). The complaint was originally given to waste on 12/2/05 but was forwarded to wastewater for follow-up on 12/5/05. Joel Boulduc with IP was called on 12/5/05 to find out what type of waste they may generate. He said they hauled various waste for the mill, including wastewater ash, sludge, and lime. He stated that they had an office (trailer), about 20 pieces of equipment and diesel fuel tanks that were in containment. Mr. Blackman was left a message on 12/7/05 asking for details of his complaint. He called back on 12/9/05. His concern is the leaking/pouring of diesel, oil and hydraulic fluid from trucks parked at the Partridge-Sibley office. He said that the ground has been stained in areas from the years of leakage. Many trucks leak but mainly the dump trucks. His dump truck (#110) leaked hydraulic fluid. They also allowed oil and fuel to overflow on the ground during maintenance of the trucks and he also witnessed them pouring the fluid directly on the ground. He said that he stated his concerns to Mr. Bill Steen on many occasions. He stated he had pictures to back up his concerns.
