Subject: RCRA inspection of McKenzie Tank Lines (St. Marks Terminal).

On Wednesday, August 15, 2007, at 9:00 a.m. EST, I conducted an inspection of the McKenzie Tank Lines (St. Marks Terminal) (MTL) located at 535 Port Leon Drive, St. Marks, FL (Parcel ID 02-4S-01E-000-05588-000) (Latitude 30° 10' 8.23" / Longitude 84° 12' 26.445") in Wakulla County to ensure compliance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

The facility is now complying with the recommendations noted in February 28, 2007, HazWaste inspection report.

1. The facility appears to have all used oil containers properly labeled "used oil", closed and stored as recommended in recommendations a) and b).
2. The facility has not generated enough excess used oil to warrant a used oil hauler service at this time. All used oil is stored in the 205 gallon Black Beauty Heater tank for fuel this winter. No disposal of used oil has occurred since Terry Well's inspection on February 28, 2007. The facility's manager was aware that all used oil and used oil filter disposal records will need to be kept for 3 years as recommended in c).
3. MTL representatives were knowledgeable on the Federal, State and local rules and regulations as recommended in d).

The facility appears to be in compliance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
