This is in response to your letter dated October 1, 2007 concerning separation of Hydrocarbon Recovery Services, Inc. from Siemens Water Technologies Corp. To incorporate the separation in the Used Oil Processing permits, please provide for each of the Siemens Water Technologies Corp. facilities listed in Table 1 the following: (1) an updated Part A permit application; (2) Notification Form 8700-12FL; and (3) a fee of \$50 (for each facility).

Please note that Hydrocarbon Recovery Services, Inc. must demonstrate their Financial Assurance for closure cost for all the facilities. Until that time, processing of the permits are on hold and will be processed upon receipt of all four of the following items for each facility: (1) updated Part A permit application; (2) 8700-12FL Notification Form; (3) payment of \$50 fee; and (4) proof of Financial Assurance approval from the Department. Please provide this information within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter.
