Dear Mr. Neves:

Sun Coast Environmental, Inc. conducts annual refresher training for our drivers. Training includes review of our UAUOS Transporter's Manual, USCG approved Oil Transfer Manual and OPA-90 Spill Response Plan.

We have reviewed, discussed and understand the changes you noted in your memorandum dated April 19th, 2006 for Rule 62-710 that became effective June 9th, 2005.

All of our work is for the US Navy. All loads of oily liquid wastes that are removed from the base, including oily bilge water, are screened for halogens prior to removal, unless one of the following is documented:

1. The waste has been tested for TOH at a laboratory or
2. The waste is solely from pumping or cleaning virgin oil or fuel tank(s) or
3. The waste contains no oil (Example: Cleaning a potable water tank or ballast tank)

We use a "Sniffer" to screen for Halogens. The meter we use is a "TIF" brand model "ZX-1". The meter auto calibrates and zeros to the atmosphere at startup. We also carry the Dextil "Clor-D-Tect 1000" test kits which we use if the meter first detects the presence of halogens.

We use the standard green "Non-Hazardous Waste Manifest" for all loads. We note, and initial, in "Section 13" (Additional Information) of the manifest that the halogens screening has been accomplished and leave the generator their initial copy prior to departure. This eliminates extra paperwork documenting acceptable halogens content. The generator is provided with an additional copy, signed by the receiving facility, later.

On the subject of insurance, we carry one million in general liability insurance that includes a "Limited Pollution Buyback Endorsement" that covers sudden & accidental occurrences. We also carry an additional, separate, policy for pollution liability (1 million).




