Dear Ms. Swanson,

As per our telephone conversation today, as of Friday, July 4, 2008 Freehold Cartage, Inc. will be out of compliance with the 10 day rule. The reason for the non-compliance is as follows:

Freehold Cartage, Inc. accepted 5 drums of 4.1 material and 6 drums of 5.1 material on 6/24/08 as well as 5 drums of 4.1 material on 6/30/08. All of these drums were scheduled to be transported out of our Bartow facility on Thursday, 7/03/08 for delivery to WTI, Inc., East Liverpool, Ohio.

Freehold Cartage, Inc. was informed today, that due to a lightning strike at the WTI facility, they are not able to accept any material at this time. They expect to have the facility back on line within a week and we will make delivery at that time.

In the event that WTI will not be back on line within a reasonable time frame, we will make arrangements for disposal at an alternate disposal facility. I will notify you once these drums are moved out of our facility.
