Telecon with Mr. Patterson, Oils Unlimited, Inc. out of Alabama, Rick Neves, FDEP Tallahassee, Bob Snyder and Lu Burson, FDEP Orlando, regarding Oils Unlimited possible purchase of Petroleum Recall in Sanford.

Mr. Patterson stated that effective today he is shutting down all used oil operations to facilitate the take over of Petroleum Recall. Beginning Monday, Oils Unlimited will operate out of Sanford providing transportation services only for on specification used oil. They will not be picking up any "street" oil until they submit a processor permit application. He is waiting on engineer approvals in order to submit the application.

Larry Laisy is not, and will not be, an officer of Oils Unlimited which will operate as a "foreign" corporation within the state of Florida once this is filed. Larry is being retained as a consultant for an unspecified amount of time.

Mr. Patterson's son will operate the facility in Sanford. Oils Unlimited is <u>not</u> purchasing Filter Recall and will not be involved in the filter business - only used oil operations similar to his facility in Alabama. He will provide us with a "letter of cessation" which will also state that he is registered to transport used oil, will only be doing on-spec until further notice, and intends to apply for a processor permit as soon as feasible.

After the conversation with Mr. Patterson, Larry Laisy got on the phone and stated that Oils Unlimited was indeed purchasing Petroleum Recall and that he was also selling Filter Recall. Larry will send a letter outlining the sales and name changes.
