The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has completed its review of your proposed permit modification, dated and received by e-mail February 4, 2010.

The Department understands that the facility has made some market adjustments in handling its used oil filters. After a discussion of these changes with the district on January 25, 2010, the district suggested that the last sentence on Attachment III, Paragraph 13, Revision 1, Section III, Page 2 of 2 of your permit application be expanded as follows:

"Synergy may also choose to send drummed used oil filters by box truck and trailer to its Kingsland, Georgia facility for processing or other licensed filter processing operations, where the oil filters are compressed into bricks, any remnant oil is further extracted and the compressed oil filters are shipped to smelters for recycling".

The Department acknowledges such request and makes this minor modification to the referenced page of the application, which is incorporated by reference in Part I, Section 38.c. of the above-referenced permit, issued on January 26, 2010. This letter modification will become part of the permit application and the permit.
