7. Discrepancies with Process Description; if different from previews report.

Coomes Oil and Supply is a dealer of bulk fuel and lubricating oils, assorted auto parts (fan belts and hoses) and accumulates spent Atlas batteries from local service stations.

At the time of inspection, there were three (3) pallets of spent batteries. Mr. Coomes indicated the batteries are sold for two dollars each, to a local battery vendor who takes them to Jacksonvlle. If the batteries are legitimately recycled, the facility will be exempt from regulation under 40 CFR 261.6. However, written documentation nust be provided to this office, within ten (10) days, as to the ultimate fate of the batteries once transported to Jacksonville.
