Conversation: Mr. Coeey wanted to know if during sampling of the assessment wells all the metals needed to be tested or was it just iron and manganese. I looked through the files and told Mr. Coeey that for assessment purposes the constituents detected at the landfill would be included in the assessment wells. If other metals besides iron and manganese were found to be a violation, then they would be included in the assessment monitoring. To the best of my knowledge only iron and manganese have been detected. These two metals would be included in the assessment monitoring along with the other constituents presently tested.
