Mr. Kington:

According to 40 CFR 273.32, since MTI has an EPA identification number and has already notified regarding hazardous waste management activities, it is not necessary to renotify. However, once the facility meets or exceeds the 5,000 kg. storage limit, and becomes a large quantity handler of universal waste, the facility must meet all the requirements of Subpart C of 40 CFR 273. This includes training all employees relative to their responsibilities (Section 273.36), and keeping records of each shipment of universal waste for 3 years (Section 273.39).
