

Spotter training

In accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-701.710(4)(c), FAC, a trained Spotter will be on duty whenever solid waste is received in order to inspect the incoming waste and properly manage any unauthorized wastes.

Given that the facility is primarily a used oil processing facility, Spotters are trained consistent with Florida laws and rules regarding transporting, recycling, and generating used oil. Since the solid waste to be processed by the facility is contaminated with petroleum, petroleum products, or their chemical constituents, all elements of the used oil training can be applied to the handling of the solid waste to be managed at the facility.

Spotters will receive 24 hours of initial Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response training and 8 hour refresher training every three years. The Spotter training will be administered in-house by an independent third party. Training records shall be kept at the facility at all times and be made available for inspection by Department staff.
