I asked the owner if the driver knew it was waste paint/thinner and he stated he did. Your records show you picked up used oil from this facility on two separate occasions in 2011, although the owner stated he does not generate used oil. I asked him why he signed the receipt for the used oil pick up if he doesn't generate used oil and he stated he simply didn't read the receipt.

For your information, you must request permission from FDEP in order to pick up CESQG waste. If you wish to continue this practice please contact me and I will provide more details.
