

Good Morning, Augusta,

Our data base system (Fiesta and Chaz) does not allow for entering two different names under the same EPA ID. We need to determine which one of the two names is the Managed Entity Name and issue all DEP documents under that name. As a refresher, Florida Recycling Solutions has applied for a permit as used oil processor and notified as UO Fuel Marketer, UO Filter Transfer Facility, and UO Filter Processor; Aqua Clean has notified as UO Transporter, Transfer Facility and UO Filter Transporter and UO Filter transfer Facility. I think Aqua Clean also processes Petroleum Contact Water (PCW) and may have a permit from the water section, however they did not mark PCW Handler on the 8700-12 Form recently submitted.

We talked with Mike about the two names- one EPA ID issue. He suggested Bheem , you and I discuss this matter and if needed, do a conference call with WD Miller III ,General Manager for both facilities, and negotiate with him the Managed Entity Name.

Please advise how to handle this.
