Conversation:

I told him that the drawings and soil report/were prepared received 4/27/92 are not recent but in 1987. The site is in a low area, flood zone, and is subject to periodic flooding. Ground water level is close to the surface (1 ft.) and may rise to the surface or above it during wettest season. If the piece of land is in a flood zone he cannot operate C & D / disposal at it. He told that he has raised the ground level since then by putting fill material. I advised him to submit recent survey with elevations and information about the highest ground water level during the wettest season. He told he would submit after two or three weeks.

He was advised to withdraw the application at this time and resubmit it <sup>later</sup> if he wishes, with the required info.

He agreed to write a letter requesting withdrawal of the application.
