

Attachment C. Brief Description of Facility Operations

Perma-Fix of Fort Lauderdale, Inc. (PFFL) is used oil processing and solid waste processing facility located in the Town of Davie. As a used oil filter and used oil processor, transporter, transfer facility, and marketer, PFFL is subject to 40 CFR 279 and applicable state regulations governing used oil management. Used oil is stored in one of multiple tanks located within the southern most tank storage area. There are no underground tanks or underground piping located at the facility. All above ground tanks, piping, and ancillary equipment is secondarily contained. Used oil is processed at the facility utilizing proprietary physical and chemical methodologies. Used oil and non-hazardous waste are tested in accordance with the facility's Waste Analysis Plan (located in Attachment E.)

PFFL is also a solid waste processing facility. PFFL receives non-hazardous wastes from CERCLA and non-CERCLA sites. PFFL consolidates non-recyclable, non-hazardous oily sludges and other non-hazardous wastes from drums and other containers into a roll-off container. The roll-off container is then shipped offsite to a permitted municipal landfill.

Additionally, PFFL is also a hazardous waste transporter, 10 day hazardous waste transfer facility, and a biomedical waste transporter and storage facility. PFFL is also a transporter, transfer facility, and small quantity handler of universal waste lamps and devices.

As of the date of this application, PFFL has 23 employees.
