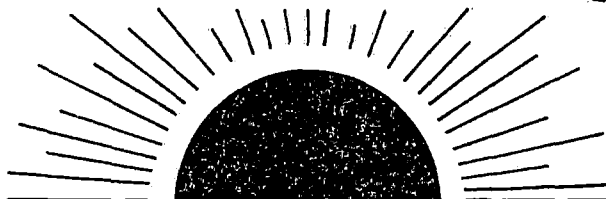



Failure to provide secondary containment for containers and an existing aboveground used oil storage tank. See Item A. And refer to County Inspection left at your office at our last meeting. *Should say pass/fail*

Failure to clean up used oil released to the environment. Son Glow Laboratory & Associates, have been contracted to take samples and over see any clean up.

Failure to register with the Department as a used oil marketer and as a used oil transfer facility. See Item E. Necessary Services has been registered with the State and E-1 shows change in manifest by Oils Unlimited to show used oil collected.



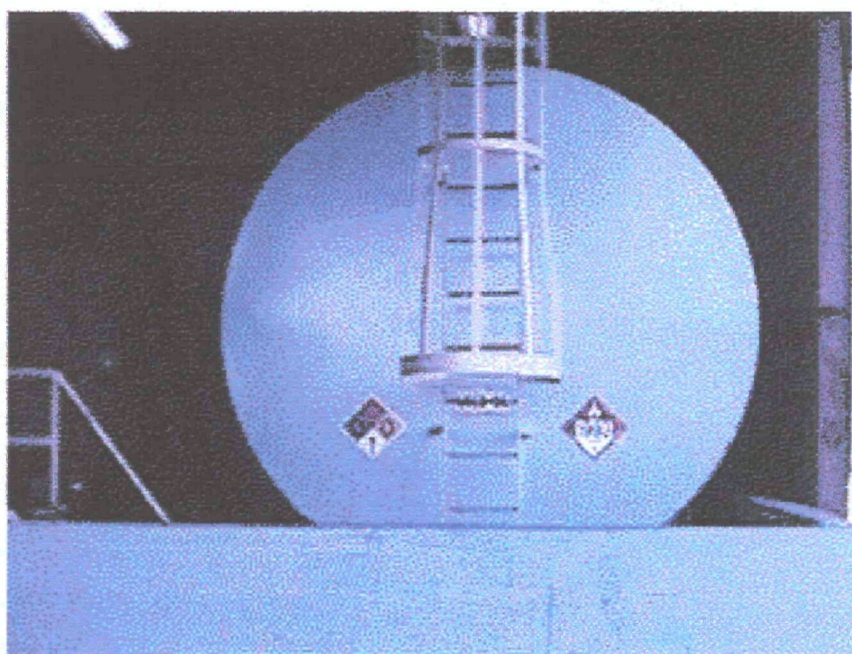

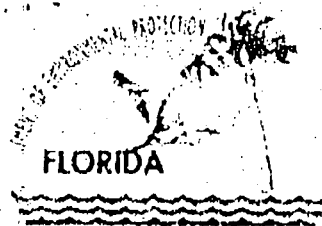

We are pleased to submit the enclosed revised sizing of the secondary containment structure. It is our understanding that the three 10,000 gallon vertical tanks are not to be placed inside the secondary containment structure and that only the one 10,000 gallon and one 1500 gallon horizontal tanks will be placed inside a containment structure 24 feet by 20 feet. The secondary containment structure was sized according to a sketch provided by Necessary Services that showed the approximate horizontal dimensions of the containment structure, as well as the volume of the above ground tanks. The diameter of the vertical tanks and dimensions of the horizontal tanks were provided by Necessary Services during a telephone conversation with Mr. Mark Byington. The height of the secondary containment structure was calculated using a United States Environmental Protection Agency 1999 Guidance Document for Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan based on rules that were in effect on December 31, 1998.

Necessary Services also estimated that the 10,000-gallon horizontal tank sets approximately 3 feet above the concrete floor slab. The calculated height of the containment structure is only valid for the information provided by Necessary Services.
