
Re: Used Oil Transporter / Transfer Facility Letter of Self-Insurance

To whom it may concern:

Please be advised that Duke Energy Florida, Inc. (formerly Florida Power Corporation dba Progress Energy Florida, Inc.) self-insures public liability exposures with no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence limit that provides coverage including vehicle insurance and pollution coverage for sudden and accidental alleged or threatened discharge, dispersal, seepage, migration, release or escape of used oil, and includes any cost or expense relating to pollution damage, and is exclusive of legal defense costs, for which we, as a transporter, are legally liable.
