Dear Mr. Valentine:

On 16 December 2014, the City of Jacksonville's Environmental Quality Division's Hazardous Waste Activity conducted a Hazardous Waste Verification Inspection at your facility, **USEPA ID# FLR000213964**. As a result of the inspection, it has been determined that your facility was operating as a generator of **non-hazardous, but otherwise regulated, waste**. This waste generator classification indicates that your facility generates wastes (such as used oils, used antifreeze, lead-acid batteries, etc.) that are not classified as hazardous wastes, but have characteristics that require that they be managed and disposed of in accordance with specific regulations.

The following area of concern was identified during this inspection:

1. A hazardous waste determination must be made on the parts washer sludge prior to disposal.

The above area of concern should be addressed as soon as possible to ensure your facility is in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local regulations.
