
It should be noted by the DER and the EPA that great and extensive effort and time has been dedicated to complying in every possible manner with the requests and requirements of the respective agencies.

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Dear Mr. McVety:

These revised pages address all of the technical information requested and much of the conditional information. In many cases it is impossible to address some aspects of the regulation prior to completing construction. All of these aspects will be addressed before the plant becomes operational, as discussed in our meeting with you on January 19, 1983.

Since this permit application has undergone several revisions in order to avoid confusion, each revised page is numbered and dated. Use only the most current revision. The most recent date for revisions is 1/20/83. The revised date is found in the upper right hand corner of the new page.

In some cases pages were added. These pages are numbered with a letter following the number. For example, page 105A is to be placed between 105 and 106. If more than one page has been added then each letter of the alphabet is used with A preceding B, B preceding C, etc. In some cases pages have been deleted. A revised page for the deleted page is included indicating that the page is to be removed. In addition please delete the alternate drawing on the drum storage building print dated 11/15/82.
