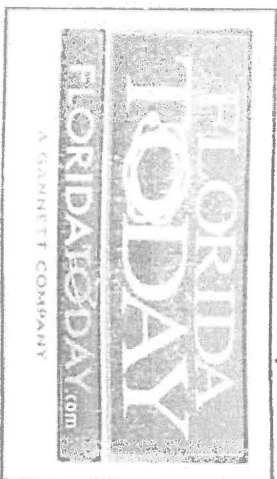

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) GIVES NOTICE OF ITS INTENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT UNDER SECTION 403.222(1)(D), F.S. AND 62-739 OF THE FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE FLORIDA AERC.COM, Inc. of West Melbourne with respect to the facility at 4317 J. FORTUNE

Place: Florida, having assigned facility ID number FID 509 282 754.

The draft RCKA Permit contains the conditions for Operating Permit 0072959-HQ-006. The Permit is intended to be issued to operate a mercury containing lamp and device storage and mercury recovery facility at AERC.COM, Inc. of West Melbourne, Florida.

Copies of the application and draft Permit are available for public inspection during normal business hours 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at FDEP, Orlando District Office, Suite 232, 3319 Maquere Boulevard, Orlando, Florida 32803-3761, 407-897-4300 and a Division of Compliance Assistance Program, Bob Martinez Center, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, (850) 245-8781. Electronic copies of the application and draft permit can be accessed in the Department's OCCULUS data system located at <http://dawnems.dsp.state.fl.us/Occulus/#viewDetail>.

A person whose substantial interest are or will be affected by the intent to issue may petition for an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 AND 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in FDEP, Office of General Counsel, 3300 Central Expressway, Suite 3300, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant and any parties entitled to written notice under Section 120.604(3), F.S. must be filed within 45 days of publication of this notice or receipt of the intent, whichever occurs first. A petitioner shall make a copy of the petition available for public inspection and review at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request a hearing under sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the filer's expense and shall not affect the filing of a petition in compliance with Rule 28.106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which FDEP's action is based must contain the following information:

- (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the applicant's name and address; the FDEP Permit File Number; and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which FDEP's action is based shall state that no such facts shall dispute and otherwise set forth above, as required by Rule 28.106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means the FDEP's final action may be different from the position taken by it or interests (i.e., persons whose substantial final decision will be affected) have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Any person may request a public meeting regarding the proposed 403.222(1)(D) F.A.C. equivalent for a public meeting is not equivalent to a request for a formal or informal administrative hearing. Public meetings are not evidentiary in nature, and information submitted at a public meeting is for non-binding consideration only. A public meeting is not subject to court or appellate review. A request to court or appellate review must be filed in the office of request at Council Agency's law, within 25 days of publication of this notice. Failure to file a request for a public meeting must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel Agency Clerk, within 45 days of the publication of this notice. Filing within this time period for a public meeting constitutes a waiver of any right of a person may have to request a public meeting under Section 403.222(1)(D), F.S.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.
