**EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT LIST:**

The CEMEX Miami Plant has the following mobile equipment available to respond to an oil spill:

- CAT 988 K loader – large loader that can be used to transport berm materials to a spill site to establish containment
- CAT 988 G loader- – large loader that can be used to transport berm materials to a spill site to establish containment
- CAT 980 H Loader— large loader that can be used to transport berm materials to a spill site to establish containment
- CAT 773 Haul Truck- 50-ton truck that can transport additional materials if needed.
- Mack Dump Truck- 20-ton truck that can transport additional materials if needed.
- CAT skid steer- small loader to establish berms in tight locations where larger loaders can't access
- Water Truck- clean surfaces when spill is contained this works with large industrial wet/dry vacuum truck
- Vacuum Truck- see above large industrial wet/dry vacuum truck
- Sweeper- final clean up if needed picking up material that has absorbed spills
- Fork Lift- transport spill containment equipment to site, oil dry, absorbent towels and socks
- Combination / Backhoe- small loader to establish berms in tight locations where larger loaders can't access
