

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION GIVES NOTICE OF ITS INTENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT to Howco Environmental Services, to Operate a Used Oil and Material Processing Facility located at Howco Environmental Services, Florida, 843 437d Street South, Saint Petersburg, Florida, 33711, having assigned Facility I.D. Number FLD 152 764 767.

The draft permit prepared in accordance with the provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-160, 62-701, 62-710, 62-730, 62-740, 62-762 and 62-780, of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), contains the conditions for Operating Permit Number(s) 33721-006-HO and 33721-007-50. The permit is intended to be issued to allow Howco Environmental Services, Saint Petersburg, Florida, to operate a Used Oli and Material Processing Facility at 843 43rd Street South, Saint Petersburg, Florida 33711.

Copies of the application and the draft Permit are available for public inspection during normal business hours 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Southwest District Office 13051 North Telecom Parkway, Temple Terrace, Florida, 33637, (813) 470-5700, and at Division of Waste Management, Permitting and Compliance Assistance Program, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, (850) 245-8781. A person whose substantial interests are affected by the above proposed agency action may petition for an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.559 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filled (received) in the Department's Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mall Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 or <u>Agency Clerk@dep.state.fl.us</u>. Petitions filed by the permit applicant and any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this Intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice of intent or receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. A petitioner shall mall a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filling. The failure of any person to file a petition (or a request for mediation, addiscussed below) within this time period shall constitute a walver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filling of a motion in compilance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner, or a statement that there are no disputed facts; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the rellef sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.
